COLUMBIA FALLS — Albert D. Richard Jr., 86, died June 10, 1992, at a Portland hospital after an illness lasting a few months. He was born in Columbia Falls, Jan. 25, 1906, the son of Albert Sr. and Clara (Cummings) Richard. He graduated from Columbia Falls High School, Class of 1924. He worked his way through three years at Colby College, Waterville, and graduated from the University of Maine, Orono, in 1966, with a BS degree in education. He taught at high schools in Steuben and Cherryfield early in his career and was principal of Addison High School for seven years. He later taught at and retired from Narraguagus High School. He was principal of Columbia Falls High School for 26 years until its consolidation. He was a member of the Maine Principals Association, the Maine Teachers Association, the Washington County Schoolmen's Association, and the Maine Retired Teachers Association. He was a blueberry grower and was associated with the industry for more than 50 years and also enjoyed farming part-time. He served on the board of directors of the Pleas-

ant River Canning Co. and served on MSAD No. 37 Board of Directors. He was a selectman and later treasurer of Columbia Falls. He was a member of the Columbia Falls Methodist Church, serving on several church committees throughout the years. He was a member of the Columbia Falls Cemetery Association, the Columbia Falls High School Alumni Association and was the first recipient of the Columbia Falls Alumni Association's Who's Who Award. He was also a member of the Masonic Lodge of Addison. Surviving are his daughter, Cecile of Portland; one granddaughter, Rebecca Reardon and her husband, David of South Freeport; one grandson, David Thompson of Orono; a great-grandson, Alex Reardon; several nieces and nephews. He was predeceased by his wife of 44 years, Julia (Bucknam) Richard; his second wife, Helen (Peters) Richard; and one sister, Mary R. Bailey. Visiting hours will be held 6-8 p.m. Saturday at the

Campbell Funeral Home, Cherryfield. Funeral services will be held from the Columbia Falls Methodist Church 2 p.m. Sunday with the Rev. Jean Marsh and Elder James Bucknam officiating. 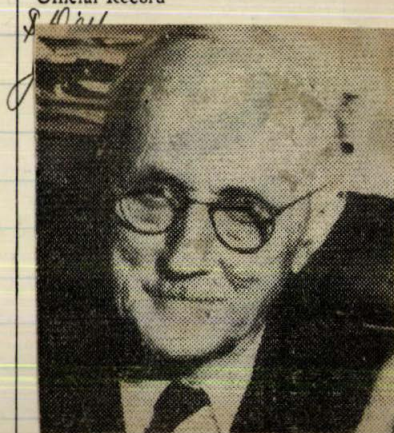
