WISCASSET — In the 1959 Wiscasset High School yearbook, you'll find Wayne Douglas Adams's quotation: "A rolling stone gathers no moss."

Mr. Adams lived his life by that motto. In his 59 years, he traveled the world — Australia, Egypt, Scandinavia.

He died April 28, 2001, at Mid Coast Hospital in Brunswick.

Mr. Adams was a marine engineer with American Export Lines from 1962, when he graduated from Marine Maritime Academy, until 1969. In those years he sailed the Indian Ocean, the Panama Canal and much of the rest of the world.

He was born in Damariscotta on Aug. 2, 1941, the son of Byron A. and Eunice M. (Nerbonne) Adams, and despite years on the ocean, a year in Australia and seven years in Schenectady, N.Y., he remained a Mainer. He was a Red Sox fan, but more than that, he was the quintessential reserved Mainer.

Mr. Adams was an accomplished man. The year he spent in Australia for General Electric, where he went to work in 1969, he was supervisor for the installation of gas turbines in new ship construction. It was the first installation of a heavy duty gas turbine in a merchant ship. His other years at GE were in Schenectady.

In 1977, he went to work at Bath Iron Works as a ship superintendent. He took early retirement in 1994, and went to work at L.L. Bean as a security officer — a job he took seriously, yet which allowed him to relax a bit, at least when he wasn't working.

Mr. Adams was a member and, like his father and grandfather, past master of the Lincoln Lodge No. 3 of Masons in Wiscasset. He was also a member of the Cora Temple Shrine and the Wiscasset Yacht Club. He enjoyed spending time with his family and grandchildren, and hunting and fishing.

Surviving are his mother, Eunice M. Adams, and his wife, Sandra L. Adams, both of Wiscasset; his son, Clay A. of New Gloucester; a daughter, Mrs. Joe (Nicole) A. Ray of Bath; his brother, Neal F. of Indian Head, Md.; and three grandchildren.

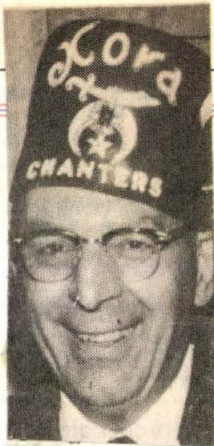

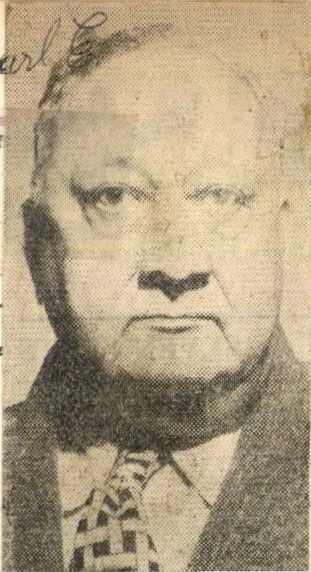

THE REV. JAMES E. AIKINS pastor of the First Congregational Church at Windham Center the past 45 years, and dean of settled ministers of the Congregational-Christian Conference of Maine if not of Protestant churches in Maine, died this morning at his home in Windham. While in failing health in recent months he had continued in charge of services and work of his parish up to within a few weeks. He had been active in the ministry of the denomination 51 years.

Mr. Aikins was born in Aylmer, Province of Ontario, Aug. 25, 1855, and received his theological training in Bangor Seminary, from which he was graduated in 1885. That year he was ordained a minister of the Congregational denomination and became pastor in Cape Elizabeth. He also held pastorates in Princeton and Vassalboro before accepting a call to the Windham Center church in 1891.

His pastorate in Windham was marked by a warm hearted pastoral service, which extended beyond the membership of his own parish, and he was in frequent call to officiate at funeral services and marriages outside his immediate church. He was an able leader as preacher and pastor, and his long service with the church testifies.

For more than 40 years Mr. Aikins served as scribe of the Cumberland Association of Congregational Ministers and Churches, being succeeded in this office within a year or two, when he was made honorary moderator. He also served on various committees in the Maine Congregational Conference for many years. In Windham he was for a number of years a member of the Supervising School Board. He was a member of Presumpscot Lodge, F. & A. M., of Windham, and of the Windham Kiwanis Club, in which he took special interest in his more active years.

In 1932 Mr. Aikens enjoyed a trip to England, where he visited, one of his daughters, the former Miss Ellen Aikins, and her husband, William Hindle, engaged in Y. W. and Y. M. C. A. work in India and then on a furlough in the island kingdom.

Mrs. Aikins died a few years ago, and Mr. Aikins is survived by eight children, Mrs. Ellen Hindle, who was at one time secretary of the Portland Y. W. C. A.; William Aikins of New Haven, Conn.; Frederick J. Aikins, superintendent of schools of Windham and Gray; Walter B. Aikins of Portland; Miss Emily Aikins, who has kept house for her father, Lincoln and Nelson Aikins, who are engaged in teaching in Montana, and Mrs. Alice Boothby, wife of Albert Boothby of Massachusetts.
