### longtime high school principal

DAYTONA BEACH, Fla. — Loring R. Additon, 88, of Daytona Beach and Greene, Maine, a longtime high school principal and school superintendent, died March 10 at a local hospital.

He was born in Greene, a son of Fred L. and Lenora Howe Additon, and graduated from Leavitt Institute, Turner, Maine, and Bates College, Lewiston, Maine, with a bachelor's degree, and the University of Maine with a master's degree in education.

In Maine, he was a high school principal in Columbia Falls, Cherryfield, Machias and Ellsworth. He served as superintendent of schools in Calais for three years and Bath for 20 years.

Mr. Additon was a life member of the Maine Teachers Association, the National Education Association and the Maine Congress of Parents and Teachers. He was past president of the Maine Teachers Association, a member of the Maine Principals Association and the Maine Superintendent's Association. He was the only person ever elected president of all three associations.

He was a past president and honorary life member of the Bath Rotary Club and 50-year honorary member of the Masonic Blue Lodge, Scottish Rite Order and Anah Shrine Temple.

Surviving are his wife of 64 years, Phyllis G. Additon; and a daughter, Noreen Hanscom of Cape Elizabeth, Maine.

## YALE D. ADELMAN

MARS HILL and GREEN VALLEY, ARIZ. Yale Donald Adelman, 83, of Mars Hill, died May 19, 1998, at a Tucson, Ariz. hospital. He was born June 12, 1914, in Mars Hill, the son of Hiram and Katherine (Goldsmith) Adelman. Until his retirement, he had worked as a potato grower and shipper. Yale Adelman was a respected and beloved member of his community, both in Mars Hill, where he was born and lived his entire life, as well as in Green Valley, Ariz., where he and his wife spent their winters. He was a graduate of Aroostook Central Institute, Mars Hill, and the University of Alabama. In addition to his family and friends, service, charity and education were most important to him. Mr. Adelman was a president of the Aroostook Hebrew Community Center, as well as a president of the B'nai B'rith. In Green Valley, Ariz., he was a member of the Jewish Community Foundation of Green Valley. He was an active supporter of the Mars Hill School System and served as a member of the University of Maine (Presque Isle) Foundation. Mr. Adelman, a charter member and the second president of the Mars Hill Rotary Club, was the recipient of the Rotary's internationally recognized Paul Harris Award. He was also a Free Mason of the Mars Hill Masonic Lodge. He was instrumental in the founding of the Aroostook Mental Health Center, serving as president and then as a member of the Board of Directors. He also sat as a director of the Northern National Bank. He was a sports enthusiast and an avid golfer. In his high school years, he was well known throughout the state of Maine for his participation in many championship baseball and basketball teams. He was a member of the Mars Hill Golf Club, the Aroostook Valley Country Club, and the New England Club of

Green Valley, Ariz. Yale Adelman was respected for his integrity, admired for his quiet generosity and loved for his caring and gentle ways. Surviving are his wife of 60 years, Mary Shure Adelman; his children, David and Paula Adelman of Bangor, and Susan Adelman Rudolph of Greenwich, Conn.; his brother, Milton Adelman of Mars Hill; grandchildren, Mark and Amy Adelman of Atlanta, Ga., Kim Adelman of London, England, Beth and Andrew Warner of Columbus, Ga., Danielle Rudolph of Dusseldorf, Germany, and David Rudolph of Tokyo, Japan; many nieces, nephews, grandnieces, grandnephews and cousins. He was predeceased by two sisters, Gertrude Adelman and Elizabeth Mazer. Funeral service will be held 12 noon Sunday at the Jewish Funeral Chapel, Center Street, Bangor, with Rabbi Henry Isaacs officiating. Interment will be in Beth Israel Cemetery. Joseph Adler, 82, of Springvale, a former Lewiston resident who was employed many years ago by the Sun-Journal, died March 19 of injuries sustained when struck by an automobile.

Active in publishing circles, he served two years as president, two years as vice president and 15 years as secretary of the Maine Press Association.

At the time of death, he was serving his 39th year as secretary-treasurer of the Sanford-Springvale Merchants Association and the town of Sanford will hold a public memorial service on April 21. A scholarship fund has been established in his memory.

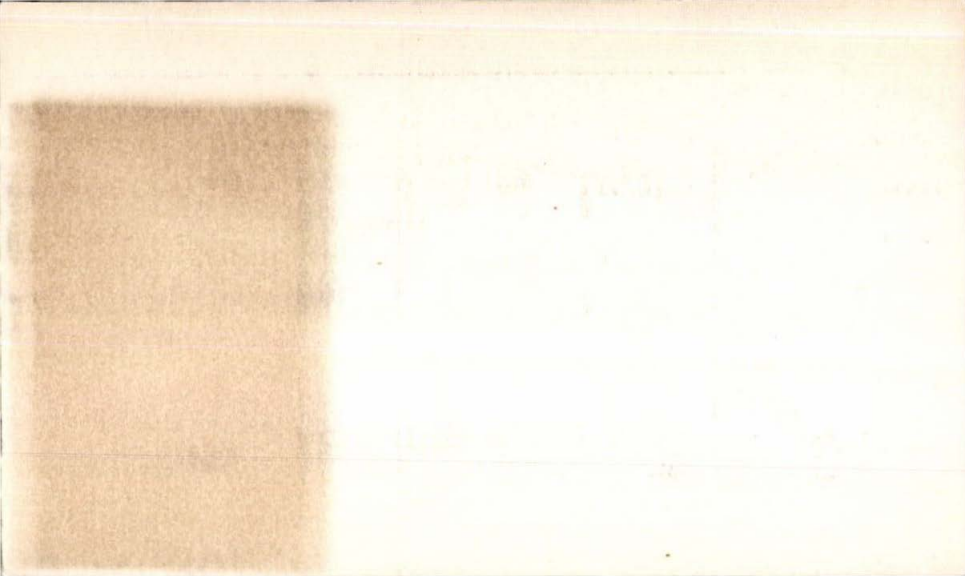
