

For more than 34 years, Mr. Albee worked with First National Stores and managed three of the company's Rockland stores.


He was active in Boy Scouts for many years and achieved scouting's highest rank, that of Eagle Scout.

Harry M. Aldrich, 75, of 85 Market St., a long-time employe in Portland's Masonic Building, died Sunday at his home after a brief illness.


