



Funeral services will be held at 2 p. m. Friday at his home. Friends may call Friday from 12 noon to 1 o. m.





During World War II, he served in the Army. Mr. Alexander was a self-employed accountant.


He was a communicant of Trinity Episcopal Church and was a member of Deering Lodge of Masons, both in Portland.
