
order to obtain his diploma.

In addition to his wife, Dottie, of Hawkinsville, he leaves seven brothers and sisters living out of the



He was a member of North Deering Congregational Church and a 50-year member of the Masonic Lodge in Caribou.


His wife died in 1992.



four grandchildren.







team.


