PORTLAND -- Charles Louis Arey Sr., 91, succumbed to chronic renal failure and congestive heart failure on March 17, 2007, St. Patrick's Day, in the middle of a Nor'easter, after a long battle. Born in South Portland on May 25, 1915, the second of five children, he was predeceased by brothers Lester, David, and Donald, and is survived by sister Eleanor McCubrey. He is also survived by: his wife of 52 years Edith (Cram) Arey; son Charles Jr.; daughters Carol Bellino, Diane Gurney, and Nancy Arey Cohen; grandchildren John Williams, Denise Rowe, Christopher Gurney, Jeffrey Bellino, Timothy Gurney, Stephanie Jordan, Robert Cohen, and Andrew Cohen; and great- grandchildren Brian Rowe, Kevin Rowe, Laurel Williams, Kaitlyn Gurney, Nathaniel Williams, Aubrey Gurney, Christopher Gurney, and Dimaggio Bellino.

Charlie began entertaining at an early age and lived his entire life to entertain and make people smile. During the early years, he played bass in the Downeasters at age 16 alongside his father, and took his father's place in a country group known as the Katahdin Mountaineers in the 1930s, continuing as a member of the group for the next 50 years, the highlight being a performance with the Boston Pops. He also entertained with the

Bear Mountain Boys, Guptill's Orchestra, and the 3 Aces.

Charlie was most proud of his years spent performing with a 12-piece Dixieland band known internationally as The Presumpscot River Bottom Boys from 1967 to 2005, when the group celebrated its 50th anniversary and he sadly put away his bass, replaced by younger musicians. With the PRBB Charlie traveled the world, performing for Governors' Retreats at Walker Point, for President Bush's daughter's wedding reception in Kennebunkport, and on several European tours, highlighted by performances at the U.S. Embassy in London, with the Hoffrau Band in Munich during Octoberfest, and multiple shows in Italy, England, France, Germany, Switzerland, and the Netherlands. In 1967, the PRBB was selected to represent the United States at Expo '67 in Montreal, and Charlie lent his unique slap bass style and voice to that performance as well.

Not able to get enough of performing, Charlie also was a member of Jimmy Hansen's 12-piece band in the late 1950s, playing with the likes of Rudy Vallee and others, and for the next 30 years led the Charlie Arey Trio, serving extended engagements at The

Mustache Cup, the very first Old Port night

spot, (before renovations of the area had begun), the Lafayette Hotel, the Prince of Fundy, and the Caribe.

Although Charlie spent his life in the spotlight, there were other sides of him as well. He worked as a machinist, insurance agent, owned a television store in the early days of television, was an oil burner technician, and spent years as a prominent real estate agent in the Portland area, going so far as to earn a private pilot's license and purchase first a Piper Cub and later a Cessna to be better able to show large properties to prospective buvers.

Charlie was active in several service organizations over the years, serving as President of the Windham Kiwanis Club, as Noble Grand for the Hadattah Lodge IOOF, as a 32nd Degree Mason, and most recently as Grand Musician of the World for the IOOF. He performed as Santa for a local orphanage, and donated hundreds of hours over the years to leading sing-alongs at nursing homes. For many years, as a member of Kora Shrine, he would load up his car with underprivileged children and take them to the Shrine Circus. And he was always the first one to visit a sick friend in the hospital or deliver a care package to a loved one. Often his family foked about his care packages because they were usually nothing anyone really wanted, but the thought and effort he put into making and delivering them warmed their recipients' hearts.

Carrying on Charlie's passionate love for music are three grandsons: Timothy Gurney, who plays percussion, guitar, keyboards, and sings in a local band; Robert, who plays piano, guitar, and sings around the country with Colgate University's Colgate 13; and Andy Cohen, who plays piano, guitar, and sings with The Blake School's Blaker's Dozen in Minneapolis. Charlie will be tapping his foot to the beat each time one of his grandsons
