humorous storyteller, and a bit of a
prankster; by those he knew and
helped in Alcoholics Anonymous
over the years as a friend and a
powerful example; and by his
friends as one of the most unforget-
table characters one is ever likely to
meet. Anyone who knew him has a
story or stories to tell.

He is survived by his uncle, Gil-
man Arnold of Spring Hill, Fla.; and
his special friends and cousins,
Bonnie Lee Nelson of Cumberland
Foreside, Nicholas Hanson of Ver-
