## Educator Warns To Destroy Pub

A top National educator said here Friday that there's a movement afoot in the Country to destroy public education. He viewed



Brunswick, Jan. 30.—Death today took the Rev. Thompson E. Ashby, DD, 69, pastor emeritus of the First Parish Church. He died in a Portland hospital after a four day illness.

Dr. Ashby, one of Brunswick's foremost ministers and teachers, served the Congregational Church as pastor for 35 years, retiring in September, 1951. Earlier this month the church and parish elected him pastor emeritus. He belonged to the Masons, Rotary, Town and College Clubs, served the Pejepscot Historical Society as president several years. His college fraternity was Sigma Alpha Epsilon.

He also found time for numerous civic activities, serving the Town as a member of the committee which prepared an historic booklet for the 200th anniversary. More recently he was named chairman of a committee whose task it will be to select citizens for commendation who have made Brunswick a better place in which to live.

Dr. Ashby came East from Nebraska where he was born in Franklin, son of Thomas F., and Betsy Potter Ashby, March 12, 1883. He married Harriet, in Ashland, in 1908, shortly after graduating from Denver University.

He was only 17 when he was graduated from high school in May, and delivered his first sermon in June. In July he received his license to preach. He had planned to enter college in the Fall, but serious illness interrupted his advanced education, so he continued preaching. He was two years late entering college but he continued to carry on his church work and even found time to play varsity football and captain the team as a senior.

He wanted to continue his education at divinity school but financial problems arose. Thus he accepted a circuit of eight churches, traveling by horse and buggy 125 miles to cover his territory. He preached three sermons each Sunday, in addition to conducting services during the week.

For two years he held a pastorate in Johnstown, Colo., seeking to collect sufficient funds for divinity studies. His break came when the school board asked him to organize a high school union to serve the area. For a year he served as both pastor and high school principal.

Even when the Ashbys went on to Harvard Divinity School, Dr. Ashby managed to continue with his church work in Melrose, Malden and Chelsea. Serious illness again interrupted his studies, this time for a year.

It was while serving as pastor in Chelsea that he was approached by the late Dr. Charles T. Burnett of the Bowdoin faculty, to accept the pastorate in Brunswick. Dr. Burnett had been sent by President William DeWitt Hyde of Bowdoin College.

Bowdoin conferred on him an honorary doctorate of divinity in 1930. For 35 years he officiated with former President Kenneth C. M. Sills at every Bowdoin baccalaureate service.
