



In July he received his license to preach. He had planned to enter college in the Fall, but serious illness interrupt-ed his advanced education, so he continued preaching. He was two years late entering college but he continued to carry on his church work and even found time to play varsity football and captain the

team as a senior. He wanted to continue his edu-cation at divinity school but fi-nancial problems arose. Thus he accepted a circuit of eight churches, traveling by horse and buggy 125 miles to cover his territory. He preached three sermons each Sunday, in addition to conducting services during the week.

His break came when the school board asked him to organize a high school union to serve the area. For a year he served as both pastor and high school principal. 


