Mr. Frederick Luther Attwood

SOUTH PARIS — Frederick Luther Attwood, 89, a former Auburn and New York City resident, and most recently a resident of South Paris, died Thursday, January 23, 1996, at the Mariner Square Health Care Facility in South Paris.

He was born in Auburn May 21, 1906, the son of Elmer Paris and Emma Greer (Dimock) Attwood. Educated in Auburn schools, he also attended Bliss Electrical School in Washington, D.C. and Conger Union School in New York City.

He was married to the former Lenora Anderson in Auburn on July 21, 1937.

Mr. Attwood was employed as a plumber and machine engineer for A.T. & T.

While a resident of New York, Mr. Attwood was a member of The Fortham Manor Reformed Church, where he served as a Deacon and as an Elder. He also served as church historian for their 250th anniversary. He served on the board of directors of 25 Synthesis Churches.

A well-known and respected Mason in both New York and Maine, Mr. Attwood began his Masonic career in Kingsbridge Lodge #1104, now Petham Lodge #112, AF and AM in Bronx, NY, where he served as Master in 1947. He affiliated with Oxford Lodge #18 AF and AM in Newbury where he served as Lodge Historian.

He was a member of Aurora Grata Lodge of Perfection and Aurora Grata Council Priests of Jerusalem, Brooklyn, NY, a member of Aurora Chapter Rose Cross of Brooklyn, where he served as third vice Master from 1962-64, Master of Aurora Consistory of Brooklyn, 32nd Degree.

He was coronator and Honorary Member, Surveyns Grand Inspector General, 32nd Degree of The Northern Masonic Jurisdiction, Ancient Accepted Scottish Rite 34, was also an Honorary Member of The Supreme Council, Grand In-Active 1, Knights.

He served as Commander-in-Chief of Aurora Grata Consistory for The Greater Brooklyn and Long Island Masonic Jurisdiction. He was a member of Trium Chapter #261, Royal Arch Masons, New York City, where he served as High Priest in 1951, a member of Adelpic Council #3, Royal and Secret Masters, New York City, where he served as Illustrious Master in 1950-51. He was affiliated with Oxford Council #16 Royal and Secret Masters of Newbury, a member of Columbian Commandery #1, Knights Temple of New York City, where he served as Emerald Commander in 1944.

He served as Grand Representative of The Grand Council of Royal and Secret Masters to The State of Idaho from 1953-56, served as Grand Representative of The Grand Commandery of Knights Temple to The State of South Carolina from 1953-56, served as Master, Illustrious for The Grand Commandery Knights Temple for The State of New York from 1949-52, a member of Knickerbocker Priory #3, Knights Cross of Honor, where he served as Prior in 1964, a member of St. Quentin Conclave, Red Cross of Constantine, where he served as Surveyns in 1970, served as Coroner General of K. V. C. H., a member of Star of Bethlehem #5 H. R. A. K. P. T., where he served as Precursor in 1971, member of Adoniam Council #43, A.M.D. and served as Master in 1970, transferring to J. H. Drummond Council #1 A.M.D. in 1984.

He was also a member of Penonah Council #4 K.M.U.S.A. and served as Chief in 1978 and became a Dual Member with Pine Cove Council #11, a member of LI College S.R.I.C.F. VII Degree and affiliated with Maine College S.R.I.C.F. as a Dual Member, a member of Red Branch of En. G.M.C. A.M.D. and U.S.A., a member of Half Moon Lodge #1, Royal Arch Masons, served as Grand Historian of The Grand Council Royal and Secret

Masonic State of Maine, a Fellow of The Grand College of Rites of The United States of America, a member of The Masonic Order of The Bath of U.S.A., a member of Ye Ancient Order of Coth, a member of Knapen Temple Shrine, where he served on The 1st Section Ritual Team.

Mr. Attwood was also an Affiliate of Rose Temple Shrine in Lewiston, a member of New York Court #10, Royal Order of Masters, where he served on The Ritual Team, a Corresponding Member of The American Lodge of Research, an active member of The Maine Lodge of Research, a member of The Publishers Society of L.M., a member, O.C. Lodge #2076 of London England. The Royal Order of Scotland, a member of Dringo York Rite College #103, a member of The Masters and Past Masters Association of The District of New York, a member of The Fraternal Union of Associated High Priests of New York, a member of The Cryptic Circle of New York, a member of The Knights Temple Commanders Association of New York, a member of The Paris Hill Country Club of Paris, a member of The Maine Historical Society, The Maine Old Cemetery Association, The Paris Cape Historical Society of Maine, The New England Historic Genealogical Society of Boston, MA., The National Geographic Society, Smithsonian Institute Society, and a member of The Planetary Society.

He enjoyed most collecting, reading, writing, photography and general.

Mr. Attwood is survived by two daughters, Cheryl, Knifline of Montclair, Pennsylvania and Layne, Hines of Hartford, Connecticut, one son, John Attwood of Hartsdale, NY, four grandchildren, and two great grandchildren.

Winterport, May 21—Lewis Atwood, 88, for half a century treasurer of the Winterport Lodge, F. & A. M., of this town, and prominent business and civic affairs all his life, died today at his home following an illness of several days with pneumonia.

Mr. Atwood was born here in July, 1844, the son of Mr. and Mrs. John Atwood, whose parents were among the first settlers of Winterport.
