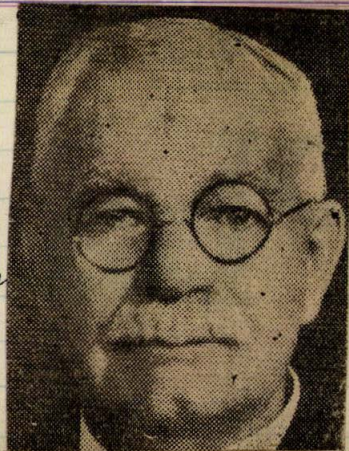

George Gardiner Austin, 83, of 25 Vaughan Street, life long resident of Portland, a Maine Central railway passenger conductor for 57 years, and prominent in many Maine lodges,

died Monday at his summer home at Little Sebago Lake, West Gray, after an illness of about two months.

BRIDGTON — Philip Robert Autio had a sense of humor so dry it often took friends and family a few minutes to get the joke.

"He'd tell some story that would sound so outrageous but because of his delivery you believed every word," said

his daughter-in-law, Lanie Knapp. "Afterward you'd see this wicked gleam in his eye and you knew you'd been had."

Mr. Autio's sense of humor - thoughtful and clever - matched the other parts of his personality, notably his love of craftsmanship and his compassion. He learned carpentry and became a skilled cabinet maker. He loved animals, raised and showed Irish setters with his wife, and near the end of his life was helping to renovate a building at the Harvest Hills Animal Shelter, where he was on the advisory board. He loved animals so much that his family listed his three dogs Beasley, Abby and Ranger - among the survivors in his obituary.

"They are all part of his family," said Knapp. "They were all shelter dogs."

Mr. Autio, 64, of Bridgton, died Dec. 8, 2001, at Maine Medical Center in Portland.

He was born in Monessen, Pa., a son of Yrigo (George) Autio and Tyne Elina Himottu Autio Bjorklund. His father was an immigrant from Finland and a Lutheran minister who moved his family to Harrison when Mr. Autio was a boy.

Mr. Autio graduated from Bridgton High School in 1965 where he was captain of the football team. He married Barbara Elaine Conant, whom he called the love of his life, on May 5, 1966.

As a young man he did some lumbering, then began learning carpentry and became very skilled at it.

"He did very beautiful work, and rather than buy prefabricated cabinets, people would hire him to build the cabinets for their home," said his daughter-in-law.

For about 20 years he also worked as a rural carrier for the Bridgton Post Office.

Mr. Autio was a member of the Kora Temple Shriners in Lewiston and the Bridgton Board of Appeals.

His interests included gardening, cooking, wine making, fishing and hunting.

Surviving are his wife of Bridgton; a son, Wesley Robert, and a grandson, Zachary Owen Autio, both of Pelham Mass.; two brothers, George E. Autio of Rockton, Ill., and P. Martin of Dunellen, N.J.; and a sister, Ruth E. Autio of Bridgton.
