Kezar Falls, Oct. 21.—Edward Richardson Bachelder, 77, for the last 30 years town auditor of Porter and previous to that town treasurer for several years, died at his home here this afternoon following an illness of a few hours the result of a shock. He was a native of Baldwin, the son of Edward S. and Elizabeth Gupstill Bachelder, and was a charter member of Hiram Lodge, Knights of Pythias, and a member of Greenleaf Lodge of Masons of Cornish. 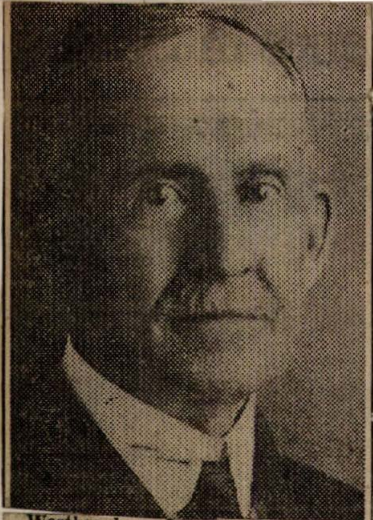
