Adelbert Wesley Bailey, practicing attorney here for the past 30 years, with offices at 11 Prospect Avenue, and counsel in at least two city administration investigations, died suddenly of a heart attack yesterday at his home, 18 Claremont Avenue. He was seventy-five. Mr. Bailey had suffered a previous heart attack last November.

In 1934 Mr. Bailey was named as counsel for a Common Council Committee which conducted a long and stormy investigation into snow removal activities and into costs of improving Mount Vernon Avenue and West Third St. Manlio Severino was his associate in handling the probe.

Revelations which came out of this investigation paved the way for a big Republican victory in the 1935 mayoralty election. Former Alderman George M. Percy was chairman of the investigating committee which conducted the hearings.

Counsel in DPW Probe

Again in 1936, Mr. Bailey was appointed special counsel for Comptroller John Lynn in the Louis Petrillo suit which split the Board of Estimate and the Common Council and led to the famous aldermanic inquiry into the operation of the Department of Public Works.

He also served as an Assistant Attorney General of the State of New York for four years, around the 1930's, under the then Attorney General Hamilton Ward. A member of the Mount Vernon Republican Club, he was long active in the Republican party and served on many campaign committees.

A descendant of John and Priscilla Alden, Mr. Bailey was born Feb. 19, 1875 in Sidney, Me. He was graduated from Bates College, Maine, with the class of 1897 and took his law degree at the New York Law School.

When the war between Spain and the United States broke out, he enlisted, but before his company could be sent to Cuba, hostilities ceased. He was a member and past commander of William Carmer Camp, Spanish American War Veterans.

Active in Masonic affairs, he was a member of Solar Lodge 4, F. and A.M., of Bath, Me., and a member of Mount Vernon Chapter 228, R.A.M., and Phoenix Council 70, R. and S.M., both of this city.

During his youth, Mr. Bailey taught night school in New York City, and before coming to Mount Vernon 30 years ago he practiced law in New York City and Brooklyn. He also was active in the development of real estate on Long Island.

He leaves his wife, Mrs. Mabel Henrietta Seaman Bailey; a daughter, Mrs. Burton Jones of Acton, Mass., and three granddaughters.

Religious and Masonic funeral services will be conducted tomorrow at 8 P. M. at Burr Davis Chapel, 15 South Fourth Avenue, with the Rev. Melvin J. Joachim, minister of First Presbyterian Church, officiating. Interment will take place Monday at Woodland Cemetery, Bellport, L. I. Friends may call at the chapel.

He moved to Oakland in 1965 and came here a year ago to live with his daughter, Mary Abbott.

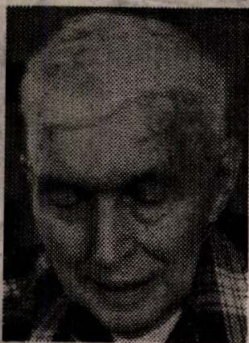
His wife, the former Gladys E. Nason, died in 1971.
