He also served as an Assistant Attorney General of the State of New York for four years, around the 1930's, under the then Attorney General Hamilton Ward. A member of the Mount Vernon Republican Club, he was long active in the Republican party and served on many campaign com-

mittees. A descendant of John and Pris-cilla Alden, Mr. Bailey was born Feb. 19, 1875 in Sidney, Me. He was graduated from Bates Col-lege, Maine, with the class of 1897 and took his law degree at the

New York Law School. When the war between Spain and the United States broke out, he enlisted, but before his com-pany could be sent to Cuba, hostilities ceased. He was a member and past commander of William

Carmer Camp, Spanish American War Veterans. / Active in Masonic affairs, he was a member of Solar Lodge 4,

F. and A.M., of Bath, Me., and a member of Mount Vernon Chapter 228, R.A.M., and Phoenix Council 70, R. and S.M., both of this city. During his youth, Mr. Bailey taught night school in New York City, and before coming to Mount Vernon 30 years ago he practiced law in New York City and Brook-
