DEL RAY BEACH Fla. — Irving Stanley Bailey, 90, formerly of Waldoboro, Maine, died April 20, 2001, in Boynton Beach, Fla.

He was born in Burnham, Maine, a son of Irving Bailey, attended Waldoboro schools and graduated from Waldoboro High School, where he played on the football team. He attended the University of Maine and received a degree in education.

He served in the Army for three years with the Office of Strategic Services, forerunner of the CIA, training recruits. His age prevented him from being sent abroad. He worked for the Massachusetts firm of Bird and Sons, then became a sales manager for Maine, New Hampshire and Vermont for Lee's Carpets and finally, owned his own business importing carpets from Turkey and Afghanistan.

At the age of 60, he and his wife moved back to Waldoboro. They would spend the winters in Del Ray Beach until his wife died in 1975. Mr. Bailey married Marjorie Cleaves and they had spent the past 23 years traveling between Waldoboro and Florida.

He had a wonderful sense of humor and a real zest for life, his family said. He enjoyed hunting pheasant and goose in the fall as well as boating, playing bridge and golf. He was a member of the Church of Palms in Del Ray Beach, King Solomon's Lodge of the Shrine and the Waldoboro Lions Club.

Surviving are his wife, Marjorie of Waldoboro and Del Ray Beach; and a sister, Gladys Chase of Bath, Maine.
