Kezar Falls, July 11-William Gilmore Bailey, who was a superintendent of schools in Maine 25 years, died at his home here July 6. He had been ill only a short time. Ernest Flood of the Kezar Falls Methodist Episcopal Church, Burial was at St. Albans, Me.
