



Clarence was a life member of the Woodford's Club, National Sojourners and VFW Deering Post. He was also a Master Mason with the Deering Masonic Lodge.


Clarence was a devoted family man who will be remembered for his sense of humor, bright and lighted ties, and electrical gadgets.
