UNION — Edgar M. Barker, 79, died Saturday, Dec. 16, 1989, at a Rockport hospital. He was born at Portland, Aug. 13, 1910, the son of Lucius and Mary (Nash) Barker. When Edgar was nine years old, his family moved to Union, where he graduated from Union High School, Class of 1928. He then entered the Barker garage business with his father, which he continued until his retirement in 1972. During his early years, he played saxophone in the Union Band. He was a recipient of the 50-year Masonic Veterans Medal. He was past master of Union Lodge, AF & AM, and past worthy matron of Orient Chapter, OES. Mr. Barker was a 32nd degree Mason and belonged to Scottish Rite Bodies of Rockland and the Maine Consistory of Portland. He was a Shriner, a member of the Kora Temple and the Midcoast Shrine Club. He was also police chief in Union, and civil defense director for many years. In addition to his wife of 55 years, Christine A. (Brown) Barker of Union, he is survived by two sons and daughters-in-law, Mr. Ronald A. and Gerry Barker and Mr. David K. and Donna Barker, all of Union; one daughter and son-in-law, Mrs. Mary A. and Fred Carey of Tenants Harbor; one sister, Mrs. Malcolm (Dorothy) Joslyn of Lake Elmore, Vt.; three grandchildren, Jeffrey Barker of East Haven, Conn., Jason Barker of Springvale and Sherry Abaldo of North Hollywood, Calif. Barker Funeral Thursday

Westbrook, April 3—Funeral services for Edward J. Barker, 47, Boy Scout official and former chief of the Westbrook Fire Department, who died this morning at his home on Cumberland Street, will be held at 2 p. m. Thursday at the residence. Interment will be in Woodlawn Cemetery.

Mr. Barker was stricken with a shock while eating a late breakfast this morning and died a half-hour later. He had been in failing health the past year but had been ill only two days.

He was born here, son of the late Charles E. and Carrie Dyer Barker, and had made his home here all his life. He had served more than 25 years as a machinist with the S. D. Warren Company and was made assistant chief engineer of the Cumberland Mills Fire Department, a mill organization, a year ago. He was vice

chairman of the committeemen of Troop Two, Boy Scouts, and an active booster of boys' activities.

He has served six terms as chief of the Westbrook Fire Department and for many years was a member of Presumpscot Hose Company. A member of the Republican Party, he served 24 years as ward constable in Ward Five. He was a member of Warren Philips Lodge, F. & A. M., the Westbrook Lions Club and Pequawket Tribe, I. O. R. M. He attended the Warren Congregational Church.

He is survived, besides his widow, who was Miss Olive McFarland, by a daughter, Miss Ruth I. Barker, teacher in the local schools; a son, Edward, Jr., and three sisters, Mrs. Royal B. Cannell, Mrs. Winfield S. Welch and Mrs. Leonard H. Emery, all of Westbrook.

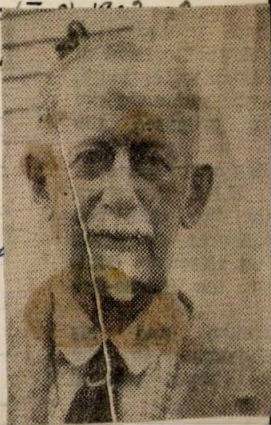

Arlyn E. Barnard, 90, longtime executive vice president of the American Automobile Association in Maine, died Friday at the Barron Center. For many years he was a radio personality known as the "Three-A Safety Man."

Mr. Barnard became general manager of the fledgling Maine AAA in 1932. In the more than 50 years that he was with them, AAA membership in Maine grew from 3,000 to 68,000.

From the mid-1930s throughout the 1940s, Mr. Barnard read classic children's stories at breakfast-time on WCSH radio. He incorporated safety messages into them and always closed with the phrase "Always alert, never hurt." He later did a similar program at WGAN radio.

In 1932, he developed the school safety patrol program in Maine. He trained students from

Butler and Lincoln junior high schools to help direct traffic and supervise fellow students at busy intersections.

After retiring in 1974, Mr. Barnard served as secretary of AAA until 1987 and a board member until 1990.

Born in Iowa, a son of Jennie Culp and Milton E. Barnard, he attended schools there. He worked at the Chicago Post Office for a while before taking a training course with AAA in Washington, D.C.

In 1926 he went to work for the Columbus (Ohio) Automobile Club. In 1927 he married the former Ruth Geyer, and they moved to Portland in 1931. They lived in West Buxton from 1939-76. In the late 1930s, he was chairman of the board of Opportunity Farm in New Gloucester.

Mr. Barnard formerly held the all-time record for volunteer time served at Maine Medical Center. He offered 7,239 hours of service to hospitalized children from 1950-61.

He was active with the Episcopal Church and in 1972, was ordained a permanent deacon.

Some of his other interests included painting, photography, travel and the Masons. He exhibited in Portland's Sidewalk Art Festival and presented slide shows of his many trips throughout the world, including his 16 trips to Japan.

He sponsored numerous children from other countries while they attended school in this country.

Surviving are his wife of 65 years, Ruth G. Barnard of Portland; three children, Nancy Barnard Seidman of Augusta, Brian Barnard of Cos Cob, Conn., and Richard Barnard of Boothbay Harbor; nine grandchildren and 11 great-grandchildren.
