## Albert F. Barnes

### retired Press Herald state editor

Albert F. Barnes, retired editor and editorial administrator for the Guy Gannett Publishing Co., died Saturday at a local hospital.

Mr. Barnes, a resident of 751 Main St., South Portland, was 76.

#### PASSAGES

Each day the Press Herald selects one obituary and seeks to learn more about the life of a person who has lived and worked in Southern Maine. We look for a person who has made a mark on the community or the person's family and circle of friends in small but lasting ways.

He was born in Portland, the son of Fred W. and Margaret B. Barnes. He attended local schools, graduating from Deering High School in 1936, and then joined the former Portland Evening News.

Mr. Barnes served in the Navy during World War II, and joined the Press Herald after leaving the service. He initially covered local news and wrote a column, the Maine Vet, for the benefit of ex-servicemen.

Mr. Barnes researched and compiled editorial content for the book "Greater Portland's 350th Anniversary," published by Gannett Books.

In 1985, he became executive secretary of the Maine Press Association, and edited its newsletter until recently.

Mr. Barnes also was editor of the Kora Shrine Temple quarterly magazine, "The Sands." It recently was named first-place winner in its category by the Imperial Shrine of North America.

Mr. Barnes was a 32nd degree Mason, a member of the Hiram Lodge F. and A.M. of South Portland; Hiram Royal Arch Chapter No. 70 of South Portland; No. 2 K.T. Dr. Commandry of Portland; Portland Council No. 4, R.& S.M.; Valley of Portland Scottish Rite; Kora Temple Shrine of Lewiston, A.A.O.N.M.S.; Kora Temple Shrine Club of Greater Portland; Lake Region Shrine Club; Kora Temple Legion of Honor; Put Stevens Court #107 Royal Order of Jesters International; Longfellow

He also was a member of the Thornton Heights United Methodist Church.

Mr. Barnes' wife, Olive Barnes, died in 1986. She had worked in the advertising department of Gannett's Portland newspapers for 22 years, retiring in 1981.

Mr. Barnes is survived by a brother, Edward Barnes of Syracuse, N.Y., three daughters, Margaret F. Tripp of Topsham, Virginia B. Beauregard of Portland and Elizabeth A. Milliken of Falmouth; seven grandchildren, four great-grandchildren and several nieces and nephews.

**EAST SEBAGO** — C. Lowell Barnes, 75, well known local sportsman, died unexpectedly yesterday while he and his wife were visiting friends at a cottage on Peabody Pond, Sebago.

He was born at Pittsfield Oct. 27, 1888, son of Emery and Mary Wright Barnes. He graduated from Maine Central Institute there and Shaw's Business College in Lewiston. He later taught penmanship at the latter school.

Mr. Barnes was a private in the Army during World War I and helped form the Nelson-Dingley Battery, one of the first Maine units.

He had lived here 39 years after residing in Norway and Lewiston.

Mr. Barnes was a retired guide, storekeeper, deputy sheriff, and game warden and had operated sporting camps in the Sebago area.

He was a member of the Universalist Church at Pittsfield; a past commander of the Williams-Goodwin Post, AL, of Baldwin; and a member of Standish Lodge, AF and AM; and the Legion of Honor of Kora Temple Shrine.
