## Chandler Barron, Engineer, Dies

Chandler H. Barron, 70, a professional engineer widely known throughout the state, died in a local hospital this morning after a short illness. He resided at 21 Longfellow St.

He was born June 10, 1887, in Lewiston, the son of Chandler H. and Olive Sawyer Barron. He carried on an engineering business in Lewiston for many years and came to Portland in 1941. He married Elsie Olmstead in 1913.

He was a member of Immanuel Baptist Church, the Portland Club, and was active in Masonic groups, holding membership in Ashlar Lodge No. 105, F&AM, Rugged Cross Shrine No. 2, the King Hiram Royal Arch Chapter, of which he was past high priest, Mount Olivet Chapter No. 29, OES, and Royalty Court No. 1, Order of Amaranth. He was born in Brookline, Mass., a son of Dr. Maurice E. and Ethel Makowsky Barron. He attended Moses Brown School in Providence, R.I., from 1938 to 1943.
