Chester E. Basford

BENTON — Chester E. Basford, 86, of Benton died Tuesday, Jan. 27, 1998, at a Waterville hospital.

He was born May 21, 1911, in Waterville, son of Henry W. and Mary (Gibbs) Basford. Except for the first few months of his life, he always lived in the Benton Station area. He helped build his home here in 1940. He attended Benton Station School, graduated from Lawrence High School in 1929 and Thomas Business College in 1933.

He married Marguerite Z. Clifford of Unity on Oct. 29, 1939.

In the fall of 1938 he started working at Hollingsworth & Whitney Mill in Winslow and was there through the change to Scott Paper Co. and remained with Scott as an operating engineer until his retirement in early 1974.

He became interested in stamp collecting while in high school and enjoyed that hobby throughout his life.

In the 1950s he became interested in maple syrup. He built his first two sugar camps on his lot in Unity and then his third in Benton Falls, where he continued making maple syrup through the spring of 1981 and became one of the larger producers of pure Maine maple syrup in the state.

He had a deep interest in history. Perhaps he knew more about the history of Benton and its people than any other person living today. He helped write the "History of Benton" for its 100th anniversary in 1942 and was working on material for another, but could not continue because of illness. Over the years many people have come to him for information which he was happy to share.

Town affairs always were an important part of his life. Programs for Benton schoolchildren have been of special interest. He assisted with both basketball and baseball teams at Benton Elementary School and was one of the organizers of the Little League baseball program in Fairfield, in which many Benton boys participated. He also had a special interest in the Good Will School in Hinckley, spending many hours there.

He served as a town officer for many years, as town auditor for two years, 1934-1935; on the Budget Committee (47 years) 1946-1992; tax collector and treasurer (18 years) 1952-1969; Ames Cemetery caretaker (19 years) 1974-1992; and second selectman (two years) 1977-1978.

He had a very active and rewarding life. He was an honorable life member of the Maine Maple Producers Association, member of Waterville Stamp Club, Maine Philatelic Society, American Philatelic Society and Taconnet Falls Chapter of M.G.S. He was a 57-year member of Siloam Lodge No. 90 A.F. & A.M. and a member of the Fairfield United Methodist Church. He was a charter member of the Fairfield Historical Society.

He was predeceased by two brothers, Clarence and Basil.

Survivors include his wife of 58 years of Benton; a daughter, Joyce and her husband, Jim of Sierra Vista, Ariz.; a son, William of Montpelier, Vt.; a sister, Maitland Otis of Fairfield; a granddaughter, Julie Larson of Tucson, Ariz.; a grandson, Jon Larson of Dover, N.H.; nieces and nephews.

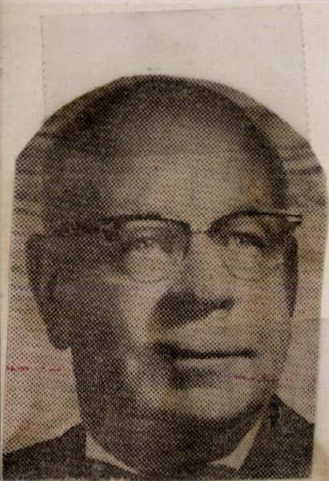

SANFORD, Dec. 10 (Special)—William Batchelder, 68, recognized as one of the outstanding business men of New England, died this morning at 5 o'clock at his home, 14 Lebanon Street, after having suffered a heart attack at his office in the Trust Company Building about 3.30 p. m. Monday. Mr. Batchelder was the president of the Sanford Trust Company, president of the Sanford Garage, Inc.; treasurer of the Goodall Securities Corporation; and president of the Sanford Building Corporation. He was born in Lancaster, N. H., and came to Sanford as a young man, first being employed in Allen's Tag Office, printing concern. He was the first bookkeeper of the Goodall Worst-ed Company and later served as sup-
