John E. Bates, 65, died early Tuesday morning at a Waterville hospital. He was born in Oakland, June 29, 1920, son of Bernard and Daisy (Later) Bates.

He was educated in the Lewiston area and attended Thomas College, Waterville. In 1940, he enlisted in the U.S. Army and was discharged in 1943, due to a disability.

He married Ethel Philbrick in Waterville, Oct. 21, 1950. He had lived in the Waterville area for over 40 years.



He was a member of the Universalist Unitarian Church, Waterville, of which he was a treasurer for 16 years. He was past commander of the Veterans of Foreign Wars, a member of the Ernest A. Rutter Post, Oakland; the Bourque-Lanigan American Legion Post; Disabled American Veterans; American Association of Retired Persons; Waterville Lodge of Elks; Maine State Grand Lodge of Wales; Waterville Masonic Lodge; Waterville Masonic Club; Taconnet Chapter of Royal Arch Masons; Mount Lebanon Council, Oakland; St. Omar Commandry, and was a 32nd Degree Mason.

He was also a member of the Kora Shrine, Lewiston, of which he was made ambassador several years ago; Ticonic Shrine Club, Vassalboro; Kennebec Valley Shrine Club, Gardiner; Mid-Coast Shrine Club; Central Maine Shrine Club, Skowhe-

gan, and Martha Washington Order of the Eastern Star, Waterville.

The sudden death of John L. Bates, 71, came as a distinct shock to his many friends in this city, where he has resided for the most part since 1905. He had been assistant foreman of pattern shop of the Hyde Windlass Co., for many years, before becoming foreman in 1938, upon the retirement of the late Henry Bickle. Mr. Bates reported for work as usual Thursday morning, but complained of feeling ill shortly after and was taken to his home, 28 Andrews road, where he died soon after.

Doctor Beach was a former president of the Wayne School, and had served as superintendent of the Sun School at the First Parish Unitarian Church.

He was a Mason and member of the Cumberland Club, a president of Portland Rotary, member of the Aesculapian Club in Boston, the Fraternity Club, which he was a past president and a member of Sigma Alpha Epsilon.

Doctor Beach was a native Dedham, Mass. He was born April 7, 1879, the son of Seth Curtis and Frances Hall Judd Beach. He was graduated from

Phillips Exeter Academy in 1897, Harvard College in 1901, and received his MD at Harvard University in 1905. He was surgical house officer at Boston City Hospital 1904-1906, acting house physician at the Boston Lying-In Hospital, 1906, and house physician at the Massachusetts Eye and Ear Infirmary in 1907.

He was married Oct. 7, 1909, to Louise Harris. Survivors include his widow.
