Upon completion of high school at Wethersfield, Conn., he entered the U.S. Navy and, served during the Korean conflict. He worked for Southern New England Telephone Co. as a lineman and worked a number of years as a Connecticut State Trooper.

In February 1968, he moved to Belfast, where he joined the Belfast City Police Department and the Waldo County Sheriff's Department. Mr. Beattie also worked a farm and had a Maine Certified Master's Electrical License.

His life history and background gave him a taste for life on the sea. He worked for Eastern Maine Towage and was an engine operator on tug boats. Pictures and memorabilia in his home include such acquaintances as J. Edgar Hoover, Ed Muskie, Hubert Humphrey, Al Gore, George Mitchell and John Baldacci.

Mr. Beattie had achieved the 32nd Degree Scottish Rite of Free Masonry and was an active Shriner.

As a teen-ager, he had transported mailbags by horse and buggy between the post office and the former train station at the foot of Knox Street.

"When he was in his early teens, he started delivering on Saturdays for 50 cents an hour," said his wife, Maxine

Mitchell-Beckett. His earnings of \$18 per week during the Depression were considered substantial wages, said his wife. At age 16, he was the sole support of his widowed mother and his grandfather.

During World War II, Mr. Beckett served in the Army in the South Atlantic, setting up post offices in Rio de Janeiro and elsewhere in Brazil.

He also enjoyed repairing sewing machines in his spare time.

"He was always fixing sewing machines for elderly women," said his wife. "He never, ever charged them. He got a lot of pleasure doing that."

He was a former treasurer of the Thomaston Public Library Committee, a former member of the Thomaston Historical Society, and a member of the American Legion and the Masons.

Mr. Beckett enjoyed boating and fishing at his camp on Stone's Point, Cushing.

A lifelong resident of Thomaston, he was born on Wadsworth Street, a son of Joseph H. and Minnie Hawthorn Beckett. He graduated in 1933 from Thomaston High School.

Surviving are his wife of 46 years; a daughter, Jean P. Faustini of St. George; a son, Bradley A. Beckett of Cushing; and two grandchildren.

A funeral will be held at 1 p.m. Saturday at the Davis Funeral Home, Knox Street. Burial will follow in the Thomaston Village Cemetery.
