## Edward C. Bean

Bethel, Oct. 5—Funeral services for Edward Clarke Bean, 63, former teacher and for 23 years in the U. S. Customs service in Maine, were held Wednesday at local funeral parlors.

Interment was in Oak Hill Cemetery in Auburn.

Mr. Bean, who died last Sunday at his home here, was born at Mason Feb. 14, 1877. He prepared for college at Hebron Academy and was graduated from Colby College in 1901. He then taught in Leavitt Institute, Turner; Greenville High School, and in Lewiston until 1911, when he first entered Customs service and was for a year at Houlton. He was engaged in the insurance business in South Paris from 1913 to 1917, returning to the Customs service in the latter year. He has since been stationed at Haleb and Jackman.
