

Henry B. Bennett

Henry B. Bennett, prominent in Maine Masonry for 50 years, resident of Portland the greater part of his life, and former selectman of the town of Old Orchard Beach, died Thursday morning in Laconia Hospital, Laconia, N. H., following an emergency operation. He received a bad fall Sept 20, and was at his summer home in Lochmere, N. H., the following day, when the grove surrounding the camp in which he was staying was destroyed by the hurricane. *Sept 29-1938*

Mr Bennett, a resident of Nutley, N. J., was born in Houlton, June 26, 1850, the son of John and Nancy Kendall Bennett. In 1870 he married Georgianna Gardiner, deceased, to whom he was married for 63 years. She was the daughter of the late Matilda Cuthbert, widow of George Gardiner and wife of Benjamin Milliken, late of Milliken Mills, Old Orchard Beach.

Surviving are two daughters, Mrs. Earl C. McAllister and Mrs. F. Carroll Perkins, granddaughters, Mrs. Richard C. Daggett, Miss Georgiana Perkins and Miss Priscilla Perkins, and sons-in-law, Earl C. McAllister and F. Carroll Perkins, all of Nutley, N. J. Mr. and Mrs. Earl C. McAllister are former residents of Old Orchard Beach and Mr. and Mrs. F. Carroll Perkins and daughters are summer residents of Ocean Park.

Living in Old Orchard Beach are a sister-in-law and two brothers-in-law, Mrs. William J. Mewer, William J. C. Milliken and Ross R. Milliken. Nieces and nephews who survive are Mrs. Fred Gooch of Old Orchard Beach, Mrs. John Perley of Scarborough, Henry B. Duff, formerly of Old Orchard Beach, now of Houston, Texas, Judge Wesley M. Mewer, Clinton C. Mewer and Leon G. Milliken, all of Old Orchard Beach.

Masonic funeral services were held in Nutley, N. J., this afternoon. Interment was in Nutley.

The deceased was a 32d degree Mason, past commander of St. Albans Commandery, Knights Templar of Portland, past high priest of Greenleaf Chapter, Royal Arch Masons, past master of Portland Lodge, past grand patron of the grand chapter, OES. He was a life member of Portland IOOF and affiliated with other orders.

He was the oldest member of the Montclair, N. J., Rotary Club, and an honorary life member of the Rotary Clubs of Montclair, Rutherford and Nutley, N. J.

He entered the stamp and stencil business in 1869 in the employ of the late Edwin Fairfield of Portland, and shortly thereafter developed rug manufacturing processes that were copied throughout the United States.

He was a former treasurer of the Old Orchard Water Company, former president of the Old Orchard Light Company, former president of the Duff Construction Company—enterprises organized at the end of the last century to help develop Old Orchard.

He later managed the Bennett Manufacturing Company, a wood novelty manufacturing company located in Portland. Subsequently he established a cabinet making and antique business in Montclair, N. J., and another in Rutherford and a third in Nutley. These businesses he sold prior to his retirement three years ago. When he retired he was 85 years old, and had been in business 66 years.



Sanford, Sept. 27. — Myron E. Bennett, 71, former editor and publisher of the Sanford Tribune, and one-time town and state official, died in the Henrietta D. Goodall Hospital here tonight of injuries suffered in a highway accident at nearby Emery Mills.

Bennett was crushed in the cab of a light truck he was operating

when it went out of control on a curve on Route 109 and crashed into a tree.

Patrolman Andre Pelletier, who with Clarence Thyng, brought Bennett from the accident scene to the hospital, said he suffered back, head and internal injuries. Bennett, employed as accountant and comptroller for the Acton Fruit Growers, Inc., was returning alone from the fruit company plant at South Acton to his home at 21 Elm Street when the accident occurred at about 7.15 p. m. He died two hours later.

Long Prominent

Bennett had long been prominent in business, fraternal and civic life in Sanford. An ex-selectman, he served as fire chief for 13 years; was once superintendent of schools and a member of the Superintending School Committee.

When the Maine State Unemployment Compensation Committee was first set up, he was named first employer representative, and served in that position for eight years.

He formerly had wide business interests in Sanford. He was president and treasurer of the Sanford Publishing Company, publisher of the Tribune, for 18 years, and was president of the now defunct Casco Motors, Inc., a local independent truck manufacturing company, and he at one time owned the Sanford Pharmacy.

Intensely interested in sports, he was in his younger days manager of the Goodall Textile baseball team.

A native and life-long resident of Sanford, he was born Dec. 2, 1876, the son of Edward K. and Calista O. Willard Bennett and was educated in Sanford schools.


