
## Fred Van Ness Berry

MORRILL - Irvin S. Berry, 79, a storekeeper, poultryman and postmaster, who was active in youth groups, died Sunday at a Bangor hospital.

As a young man, Mr. Berry and his brother. Owen, operated Berry Brothers General Store here. They later expanded into the poultry business and by the 1940s, as Berry Brothers Poultry, their specialty became the raising of broiling hens.

## PASSAGES

Each day the Press Herald selects one obituary and seeks to learn more about the life of a person who has lived and worked in Southern Maine. We look for a person who has made a mark on the community or the person's family and circle of friends in small but lasting ways. In 1952, Mr. Berry took a management position with Penobscot Poultry Co., and was in charge of their growing operation.

"Irvin was as nice a person to work for as you'd ever find," said Paul Andrews, a friend and co-worker at Penobscot Poultry. "He and another guy used to oversee the growing of three and a half million birds at a time, all broilers and roasters."

Mr. Berry took early retirement in 1969, when the Penobscot Poultry

plant in Belfast was sold. Not wanting to sit idle at age 56, he got the job as Morrill postmaster, a job he held for 15 years.

"He liked his job as postmaster, because he enjoyed dealing with people, and he already knew just about everybody in town," said his son, James of Kennebunk.

Mr. Berry worked several years with the Boys Brigade Program and was active as a Boy Scout leader. He was a former president of the Waldo District Council of the Boy Scouts and he received a Silver Beaver Award from the Katahdin Area Council.

Mr. Berry lived 55 years on Main Street, about 100 yards from his former store. A longtime president of the Morrill Historical Society, he helped establish the Veterans Memorial in Morrill, researched many of the older houses in town, and also did some genealogy studies.

He served on the Morrill-area school board (SAD 34) for 12 years, and was a treasurer and deacon of the Morrill Baptist Church. He was on the church building committee after the old church burned in 1972.

An active Mason, Mr. Berry was a master in the Blue Lodge, a high priest, illustrious master and commander. He was a sixth-degree member and a past master of Honesty Grange. Last May, he received a community Citizens Award from the Honesty Grange. Born in Knox, a son of Perl and Olive Blood Berry, raduated in 1931 from Freedom Academy. In 1938 larried the former Avis Blodgett. Surviving are his wife, of Morrill: a son, James R.
