Long interested in civic affairs in Portland, Mr. Berry was a staunch supporter of the Manager-Council form of city government. His devotion as a member of the Council resulted in his giving much time to the problems the Council faced. He was chairman of the Council in 1936, 1938 and 1941. He had never missed a regular meeting during his entire tenure of service. As chairman of the Portland Council of Industrial Progress, to which office he was elected in 1936, he gave of his time and effort without stint.

## Tributes Paid Berry

Commenting on Mr. Berry's death, City Manager James E. Barlow said: "This community has lost a real citizen, a man who accepted his full citizenship responsibility and did his part. Edward C. Berry was."

## EDWIN V. BERRY

1915-1999

FARMINGTON — Edwin V. Berry, 83, of Farmington, died Tuesday, March 16, at Franklin Memorial Hospital.

He was born Oct. 19, 1915, on the Holley Road in Fairbanks, the son of Charles W. and Alice (Goldsmith) Berry. He was educated in the schools of Farmington, graduating from Farmington High School in the class of 1933. After graduation he worked as secretary to Ted Hodgkins, President of Forster Manufacturing Co.

In 1940 he helped put into operation the local selective service and upon returning from his war time duties with the First Allied Airborne serving in Africa, Sicily, England and France, he continued to work for the Selective Service where he became known as "Mr. Selective Service" until the opera-

tions closed in 1974.

In 1956 he helped organize a Reserve Unit, becoming 1st Sergeant. They belonged to the Field Ar-

tillery and trained for two summer weeks at Camp Drum, N.Y., and later at Fort Dix, N.J., where they trained recruits for the Infantry. He retired from his outfit in 1976. He worked as bookkeeper for Ferrari's for several years and then as sales clerk, also worked at Mick-

ey's, all the while serving as one of the most active officers of the local Roderick-Crosby American Legion Post in Farmington. He was a member of the Maine Masonic Lodge 20 AF&AM of Farmington.

He is survived by a sister-in-law, Joan Berry of Farmington; many nieces, nephews and cousins.

Predeceased by two brothers, Raymond and Maynard.

## Frank Lawrence Berry, 79

WISCASSET — Frank Lawrence Berry, 79, of Birch Point Road died Sept. 13, 2001, at his home.

Livermore— Howard C. Berry, 80, a lifelong resident of Livermore, died Sunday, June 22, at his home surrounded by his family, following a lengthy illness.

He was born in Livermore Falls on Nov. 3, 1922, the son of Lewis C. and Erma O. Norton Berry. He attended grade school at the Payson Smith School in Livermore and was a 1940 graduate of Livermore Falls High School.

He was also a life deacon of the North Livermore Baptist Church, where he also was a member of the choir; master of the Norland Grange #319, which had more than 500 members during his term; past master of the Oriental Star Lodge, and Grand Vice for the Odd Fellows, Williamson Lodge #20. He had the honor of officiating at the wedding of one of his granddaughters.

He is survived by his wife of 55 years of Livermore; four daughters and their husbands, Patricia and Robert Every of Easton, N.H., Nettie and Linwood Rolfe of Lake Alfred, Fla., Margaret and James Bonney of Livermore, Emily and Keith Hemingway of Plymouth, N.H.; two sons and their wives, Nathan and Gilberte of North Windham, and Clifford and Terry of Livermore; four brothers and their wives, Rockwood and Louise of Haines City, Fla., Ronald and Glenys of Madison, Thomas and Beverly of Livermore, and Carlton and Diane of Livermore; a sister-in-law, Pearl Berry of New Port Richey, Fla.; 14 grandchildren; three great-grandchildren; and many nieces and nephews.

He was predeceased by a brother, Theodore D. Berry, July 30, 2001.

## IRVIN S. BERRY

former postmaster, Boy Scout leader

MORRILL — Irvin S. Berry, 79, a storekeeper, poultryman and postmaster, who was active in youth groups, died Sunday at a Bangor hospital.

As a young man, Mr. Berry and his brother, Owen, operated Berry Brothers General Store here. They later expanded into the poultry business and by the 1940s, as Berry Brothers Poultry, their specialty became the raising of broiling hens.

### PASSAGES

#### Each day the Press

Herald selects one obituary and seeks to learn more about the life of a person who has lived and worked in Southern Maine. We look for a person who has made a mark on the community or the person's family and circle of friends in small but lasting ways.

In 1952, Mr. Berry took a management position with Penobscot Poultry Co., and was in charge of their growing operation.

"Irvin was as nice a person to work for as you'd ever find," said Paul Andrews, a friend and co-worker at Penobscot Poultry. "He and another guy used to oversee the growing of three and a half million birds at a time, all broilers and roasters."

Mr. Berry took early retirement in 1969, when the Penobscot Poultry

plant in Belfast was sold. Not wanting to sit idle at age 56, he got the job as Morrill postmaster, a job he held for 15 years.

"He liked his job as postmaster, because he enjoyed dealing with people, and he already knew just about everybody in town," said his son, James of Kennebunk.

Mr. Berry worked several years with the Boys Brigade Program and was active as a Boy Scout leader. He was a former president of the Waldo District Council of the Boy Scouts and he received a Silver Beaver Award from the Katahdin Area Council.

Mr. Berry lived 55 years on Main Street, about 100 yards from his former store. A longtime president of the Morrill Historical Society, he helped establish the Veterans Memorial in Morrill, researched many of the older houses in town, and also did some genealogy studies.

He served on the Morrill-area school board (SAD 34) for 12 years, and was a treasurer and deacon of the Morrill Baptist Church. He was on the church building committee after the old church burned in 1972.

An active Mason, Mr. Berry was a master in the Blue Lodge, a high priest, illustrious master and commander. He was a sixth-degree member and a past master of Honesty Grange. Last May, he received a community Citizens Award from the Honesty Grange.

Born in Knox, a son of Perl and Olive Blood Berry, he graduated in 1931 from Freedom Academy. In 1938 he married the former Avis Blodgett.

Surviving are his wife, of Morrill; a son, James R. of Kennebunk; a sister, Irene A. Dodge of Morrisville, N.Y.; a granddaughter and two great-grandchildren. A son, Irvin S. Berry Jr., died previously.

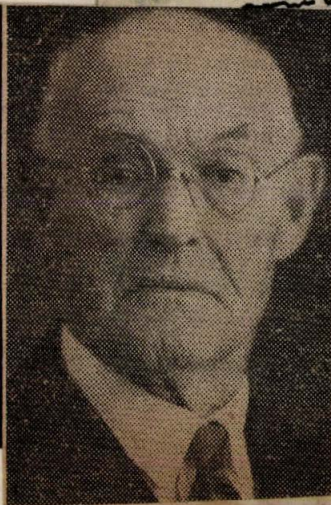
## To Be His First Flight
