Maynard E. Bessey Dies

SOUTH PARIS — Maynard E. Bessey, 60, who twice parlayed vacant apple processing plants and new ideas into flourishing businesses, died Tuesday in a Portland hospital after a brief illness. He formerly lived at 35 Roundabout Lane, Portland.

Mr. Bessey was born in Freedom, March 6, 1908, son of the late Percy F. and Ethel Penney Bessey. He worked in his late teens for the Monmouth Canning Co. at its seasonal plant in Freedom. At 21, he designed a bean pot container for canned baked beans which virtually revolutionized the baked bean canning industry.

AT 23, HE SPOTTED the vacant Conant apple packing plant in South Paris, founded the Forest City Packing Corp. and turned the plant into a pickle producer.

Eventually, pickles produced in that plant were sent all over New England..

Cucumbers for the pickles were raised in the area. It took Bessey about three seasons to get farmers here to move into enough production of what was to them a new crop.

In the Forest City venture, Bessey originally had the backing of the then principals in Hannaford Bros. Co., Portland food supplier.

In 1947, Mr. Bessey sold Forest City Packing to the D. W. Jewett Co. In turn, the plant was purchased in 1956 by John E. Cain Co. and became the Oxford Pickle Company division of Cain. The plant was closed in 1961.

USING ALMOST EXACTLY the same techniques, Bessey in 1944, had purchased a vacant apple factory in the town of Buckfield from the town which held tax deeds to it.

He had visited Buckfield in the spring of 1944 looking for a set of platform scales which he
