LEWISTON — Carl A. Bickford, 83, of Upper Main Street, Lisbon Falls, died Sunday afternoon at the Central Maine Medical Center in Lewiston.

Born in Lisbon Falls, July 28, 1907, he was the son of Horace F. and Allegra Blaisdell Bickford and a descendant of Revolutionary War soldier William Bickford, an early settler of the Lisbon area.



Mr. Bickford was educated in Lisbon Falls schools. During the early years of his working career, he was employed as an automobile mechanic in the Lewiston-Auburn area. He served for several years on the Auburn Police Department and was a deputy sheriff in both Androscoggin and Sagadahoc counties. He also had served as police chief in Bowdoinham and was later employed by the Pinkerton Detective Agency and for several years by Bowdoin College, Mr. Bickford had owned and operated a sawmill in New Gloucester, and in 1950 founded Carl Bickford Inc. of Lisbon Falls, with his son Bruce joining as a partner in 1975.

Mr. Bickford was married in Exeter, N.H., on Sept. 29, 1959, to the former Jayne Harrington, formerly of Vermont. He was a 50-year member of the Tranquil Masonic Lodge of Auburn, the Scottish Rite Bodies, Valley of Lewiston and Auburn, the Consistory in Portland and the Kora Temple in Lewiston. He was a member of St. Matthew's Episcopal Church in Lisbon Falls, a life member of the National Rifle Association and a member of the Bowdoin Historical Society.


Waiter S. Hammons of Falmouth Foreside, died in Portland Wednesday evening after an illness of several



He was a school teacher over 40 years, having taught more than 20 years in the English and history departments of Morse High School in Bath, retiring in 1978.



He was one of the founding members of the Kittery Eliot Senior Housing and Foxwell, serving as treasurer


and as member of the board of directors.


