E. Alton Bicknell, 50, well known commercial photographer in this city for 22 years and proprietor of Bicknell Studios, Inc., 15 Preble Street, died suddenly Thursday night in the Maine General Hospital, which he entered a few hours before after returning from Rochester, N. Y., where he was taken ill. He was stricken while attending a convention at studios in the New York city, and returned here with Mrs. Bicknell last evening. Acute diabetes was given as the cause of death.

Mr. Bicknell was born in Madison in September, 1886, and came to Portland in 1914, having been active in the photographic business here ever since. He built up a successful business, maintaining a studio in recent years at 15 Preble Street. He was a member of Portland Lodge, F. & A. M.; Mount Vernon Chapter, and the Order of the Eastern Star, also of the Portland Club and the Woodfords Club.

He was twice married, and is survived by his second wife, the former Miss Rose Rubin of this City, whom he married in Kennebunk; and by four children by his first marriage; Richard D. Bicknell, who is employed in his father's business; Leola M., Clinton E. and Edward Alton Bicknell, Jr., all of Yarmouth. He had resided for some years at 43 Cottage Farms Road, Cape Elizabeth.
