A rubber pipe was attached to the car's exhaust pipe and inserted into the car's closed interior, Nickerson reported. There was no note in the car, the sergeant said.

## Aldine Bird, 1/4/92 summer resident

OAKS, Pa. — Aldine R. Bird, 87, a resident of Oaks, and a summer resident of Granite Point, Biddeford, Maine, died Jan. 4 at Montgomery Hospital in Norristown, Pa.

He was born in Waycross, Ga., on April 4, 1904.

Mr. Bird was the special events editor of the Baltimore News American in Baltimore, Md., where he worked for more than 40 years until his retirement in 1973.

During World War II, Mr. Bird founded the "I am an American" Constitution Day Parade in Baltimore. Between 1943 and 1956 he organized entertainment for American troops at various military camps.

He was honored in 1974 by Baltimore veterans' organizations for exemplary service to veterans.

Mr. Bird served as deacon and Sunday school superintendent at the Seventh Baptist Church in Baltimore and the South Congregational Church in Kennebunkport.

He was a life member and holds a "32½" degree from the Mystic Circle Masonic Lodge No. 109 in Baltimore where he served as Worshipful Master in 1959. He also was a member of the Audubon Oaks Lions Club.

His next major assignment was "Mr. Fixit," which he held into the late 1940s. After serving as radio-TV editor, he was appointed special events editor, a position he maintained until his retirement in 1978.

Survivors include a son, Richard Bird of Oaks, with whom he made his home; a daughter, Elinor Riede of Searcy, Ark.; a brother Joseph Bird of Biddeford; a sister, Sue Gowan of Maitland, Fla.; three grandchildren and four great-grandchildren.

David came to the University of Maine thinking of teaching as a new career, and earned a Master of Arts in education. He taught for a year in Madison and then became principal of Winterport High School back when the town had its own high school. David left to become curriculum director, then assistant superintendent in Ossining, N.Y. He completed his doctorate at New York University where he was named a University Scholar, an honor awarded for work at New York University. He came to the University of Maine in 1962 and taught in the College of Education for 28 years until his retirement. He was originally the graduate adviser for students in education and taught introductory courses and graduate courses. His special field of study was education law, and he taught numbers of students who became principals and superintendents about law as it pertained to Maine schools. It was here at the college he met his wife, Dr. Isabel (MacPherson) Bishop. They were married for 44 years. David was a sports fan and he played basketball and baseball all through high school. He was also an expert distance swimmer and diver. He coached teams in Winterport and Madison and taught swimming and boating safety to campers in Maine and Massachusetts. David loved music. He knew the words to every "patter" song of Gilbert and Sullivan. He discovered Celtic music while spending summers at their summer home on Prince Edward Island. He and his wife attended festivals all summer to hear the bagpipes and Gaelic songs. David loved to read, to walk the lovely empty island beaches, to dig clams and to make clam chowder. He loved browsing in bookstores, preferably second hand, and in antique shops and flea markets where he could find strange and wonderful things. During his working years, he was a member of several professional organizations, but at his retirement

## John R. Bishop

### champion truck driver; town volunteer

WINDHAM - John R. Bishop, 71, a champion truck driver and a diligent volunteer for the town of Windham, died Tuesday at a Portland hospital.

#### PASSAGES

Each day the newspaper selects one obituary and seeks to learn more about the life of a person who has lived and worked in Maine. We look for a person who has made a mark on the community or the person's family and circle of friends in small but lasting ways.

Mr. Bishop drove tractor-trailers for 28 years for the former St. Johnsbury Trucking Co. of Scarborough, retiring in 1982. He previously drove for four years for Congdon Transportation Co.

He was a two-time champion in the Maine Truck Rodeo Championships, in 1966 and 1969, and went on to compete at National Rodeos. In 1969, he finished in third place out of 148 drivers.

In 1977, Mr. Bishop was named Maine's Truck Driver of the Year, in recognition of his spotless driving record and his extensive work as a community volunteer.

He had been Windham's civil defense director since 1983, and was the local coordinator of shelters that were set up during the 1998 ice storms.

"He's a friendly face whenever we needed him," said Police Chief Richard Lewson. "He's basically been a full-time volunteer in the community for the past 30 years. During the ice storm he spent endless days and nights with his wife right at the shelter."

Mr. Bishop was a special police officer, and he was in charge of the fire and police traffic control officers. He also transported the department's radar sets and intoxilyzer to Augusta for repairs and certification.

"John was always one for looking after people," said Charles Hammond, Windham's fire chief. "He was that kind of person - good-hearted, and a hard worker."

For the past 22 years, Mr. Bishop was the official sealer of weights and measures for the town of Windham.

He was a former town constable, a former member of the Town Council, and of the East Windham Fire Department.

In the 1970s, he held the obscure title of Windham fence viewer. In that job, he was supposed to settle boundary disputes between neighbors.

An advocate for the elderly, Mr. Bishop worked hard to get senior citizens' activities moved out of the gymnasium of the community center and into a more permanent location at the Aikens Annex, adjacent to town hall.

Born in Boston, a son of George H. and Lena M. McGuire Bishop, he attended Windham schools and served in the Navy aboard PT boats during World War II.

He was a member of the Gray American Legion and the Portland Veterans of Foreign Wars, the Teamsters union, Windham-Raymond Senior Citizens, Presumpscot Lodge of Masons, and the Family Campers & RVers.

He lived on Falmouth Road for many years and enjoyed bowling, square dancing, hunting and fishing.

A daughter, Teresa M. Bishop, died in 1960.

Surviving are his wife of 53 years, Catherine A. Bulley Bishop of Windham; a daughter, Mary E. Works of Windham; three sons, John R. Jr. of Cape Coral, Fla., Bruce W. and Joseph D., both of Windham; three sisters, Helen Cobb of Westbrook, Mildred Cole of Windham, and Patricia Brume of Windham and Florida; eight grandchildren and a great-granddaughter.

Visiting hours will be held from 2 p.m. to 4 p.m. and 7 p.m. to 9 p.m. Thursday at Dolby Funeral Chapel, 434 River Road. A funeral will be held at 2 p.m. Friday at the funeral home. Burial will follow in Smith Cemetery.

He was born Feb. 28, 1924, in Augusta, the son of Leonard L. Sr., and Elma Cheney Bishop. He was a 1941 graduate of the Portland High School. He attended Kents Hill School for 1½ years.

He enlisted in the U.S. Navy in 1943, serving as a quartermaster on a PT boat in the European Theater. He was wounded off the coast of France and hospitalized in England. He received a purple heart.

He graduated from the University of Maine at Orono in the municipal management program in 1950.

He served as town manager in Carmel and Wells. He was city

manager in Miami, Elm Grove, Wis., and Hazel Park, Mich.; and received many awards for his work.

He returned to Maine in 1972.

He was a member of the Rotary and an active Mason in Benevolent Lodge No.87 in Carmel.
