





He came to the United States as a youth and settled at Vinalhaven. He was the first blind person to be elected to the Portland City Governmen and to the Maine

Legislature. He was a Republican. In spite of his handicap, his interest in civic work and sports was outstanding. He lost his sight in 1908. He was a member of the City Council in 1923 under the mayorcouncil form of government and served as representative from Portland in the House of Representatives in 1927 and 1929 and in the Maine Senate in 1931, 1933 and 1935. He had served as a county commissioner since 1938. In 1935. Bissett was appointed to the Board of Directors of the s o Maine Institution for the Blind. He entered the institution in 1909 to take a training course. He opened a newsstand at 907 Congress Street in 1921. Three years later he became a traveling salesman for Talbot, Brooks & Ayer, local hardware firm. He originated the annual Christmas Fund for the Blind many years ago and worked on the campaign last Fall just before his illness. He was president of the Maine Fraternal Association for the Blind ten years, and president of the Maine Veterans Legislators' Association in 1933. He was a member of several fraternal organizations, including the Moses Webster Lodge, F&AM. Vinalhaven, Cogawesco Tribe. IORM, Portland, and the Portland Masonic Club, and a member of the St. Lawrence Congregational Church.


A family spokesman said Bjorklund died here Thursday because of a heart seizure.

Cemetery, Falmouth.






