SOUTH PORTLAND — Rubin Black, 99, of 200 Pickett St., whose greatest wish was to live to be 100, died yesterday in his home about two months short of his goal.

He was the oldest member of the Fifth U.S. Infantry Regiment in

Maine.

He was born in Vilna, Russia.

Mr. Black arrived in Minnesota at age 14 with two uncles and knew no English. He was put in the fourth grade at age 16 and, angry, ran away, later teaching himself. He worked in a logging camp in Minnesota and in the wheat fields of Kansas.

He enlisted in the Army in 1908 when Teddy Roosevelt was president and was sent to the Philippines, departing San Francisco as it was picking itself up after the infamous earthquake.

He returned from occupation duty in Germany in 1922 with his German bride, Gertrude Butz.

The Fifth Infantry was stationed at Fort Williams, Preble and McKinley from 1923 to 1939. Black stayed in South Portland after retiring from the Army in 1939. He ran a small luncheonnette on Great Diamond for a time and became a storekeeper at Fort Preble during World War II.

Mr. Black was a member of the Masons, a charter member of the Veterans of Foreign Wars, South Portland, and a member of the Fifth Infantry.

His wife, Gertrude Butz Black, died in 1980.

Surviving are a daughter, Lilly J. Prince of South Portland, with whom he lived; a grandson and two great-grandchildren.




He was a member of John Leo Murray Post, AL, of Harpswell and Portland Lodge, AF & AM.
