BATH — Paul E. Black, M.D., 88, died Wednesday at his home in Bath.

He was born in Wakefield, Mass., son of Fred Josiah and Nellie Elizabeth Black, and graduated from Wakefield High School in 1927. He then attended Mount Herman School in Gill, Mass., and Huntington School in Boston.

He received his bachelor of arts degree from the University of Kansas, Laurence, and his medical degree from Tufts College in Boston.

He worked as an industrial physician and had a private practice in Vermont. He was head of the Proctor Hospital and later moved to Rutland, Vt., where he had a private practice and was on staff at the Rutland Hospital.

In 1950 he moved his family to Southwest Harbor, where he was the town doctor and on staff at the Bar Harbor Hospital until 1954, when he became a flight surgeon in the Navy during the Korean War. He retired from the Navy in 1972, moved to Toms River, N.J., and opened a private practice in Brick Town.

In 1979 he retired from medicine. He and his wife moved to Westport Island.

His wife, Irma Donnell Black, died in January 1986. After his wife's death, he moved to Harvard Street in Bath.

He was a member of the Lincoln Masonic Lodge, the Lincoln Chapter in Damariscotta, the former Knights Templar in Ellsworth and the Kora Temple in Lewiston. He was a 32nd-degree member of the Scottish Rite in Meridian, Miss. He was a member of St. Phillips Episcopal Church in Wiscasset and attended Grace Episcopal Church in Bath.

SOUTH PORTLAND — Rubin Black, 99, of 200 Pickett St., whose greatest wish was to live to be 100, died yesterday in his home about two months short of his goal.

He was the oldest member of the Fifth U.S. Infantry Regiment in Maine.

He was born in Vilna, Russia.

Mr. Black arrived in Minnesota at age 14 with two uncles and knew no English. He was put in the fourth grade at age 16 and, angry, ran away, later teaching himself. He worked in a logging camp in Minnesota and in the wheat fields of Kansas.

He enlisted in the Army in 1908 when Teddy Roosevelt was president and was sent to the Philippines, departing San Francisco as it was picking itself up after the infamous earthquake.

He returned from occupation duty in Germany in 1922 with his German bride, Gertrude Butz.

The Fifth Infantry was stationed at Fort Williams, Preble and McKinley from 1923 to 1939. Black stayed in South Portland after retiring from the Army in 1939. He ran a small luncheonette on Great Diamond for a time and became a storekeeper at Fort Preble during World War II.

Mr. Black was a member of the Masons, a charter member of the Veterans of Foreign Wars, South Portland, and a member of the Fifth Infantry.

His wife, Gertrude Butz Black, died in 1980.

Surviving are a daughter, Lilly J. Prince of South Portland, with whom he lived; a grandson and two great-grandchildren.

BAILEY ISLAND—Capt. William T. Black, lifelong resident here, died suddenly yesterday. He was born here Sept. 11, 1882, the son of Edmund and Pauline Thomas Black.

Captain Black devoted much of his life to the sea, in small fishing boats, in the Navy in two wars and in cargo vessels for 18 years.

During his career as a shipmaster, Captain Black carried coal between Norfolk, Va., and New York City. He transported 1,800,000 tons in one year, a record which still stands.

He entered World War I as a naval ensign and was released as a lieutenant commander. He held an unlimited license and served as captain on the Union Sulphur Co. lines, the Munson Steamship Lines and the Boland and Cornelius line. In World War II, he was recalled into the navy and served as commander of Little Creek Base in Virginia.

He was a member of John Leo Murray Post, AL, of Harpswell and Portland Lodge, AF & AM.

His only son, Edmund F. "Rip" Black, local lobster dealer, achieved fame in track, football and baseball, while attending Portland High School and the University of Maine. He was a member of the U. S. Olympic team in 1928, the same year he won the National AAU hammer throw title.

Other survivors are his widow, the former Susie E. Bennett; three daughters, Mrs. Dorothy Webber of Augusta, Mrs. Lenora McMackin of Scarborough and Mrs. Willena Johnson of Bailey Island; two sisters, Mrs. W. W. Johnson of this town and Mrs. William Munsey, both of this town; six grandchildren and several nieces and nephews.

Funeral services will be held from the Bailey Island Community Church at 1 p. m. Thursday.
