Harrison, Dec. 8 — Dr. James P. Blake, 77, veteran Harrison physician, died today in a Portland hospital after an illness of two weeks. Dr. Blake, who had been in failing health several months, and Mrs. Blake had been passing the Winter in a Portland hotel.

He was born at Harrison Oct. 3, 1865, the son of Cyrus and Clara Richardson Blake. He was graduated from Bridgton Academy and Maine Medical School in 1892. lifetime plumber; known for neighborliness

SCARBOROUGH — Thomas P. Blake, 87, a neighborly man who spent a lifetime in the plumbing business, died Tuesday at a local hospital after a long illness.

Mr. Blake began learning his trade at age 7 from his father, Wilbur F. Blake. He always loved the business, said his son, W. Franklin Blake, and he had fond recollections of his early days working with his father, when they used Portland's electric streetcar system to get around the city.

Mr. Blake was a plumber many years with his father's company before eventually taking over its management along with his two late brothers, Ralph Blake and Howard Blake.

The company's strength was always in residential plumbing, installing and repairing bathrooms, kitchens and sewer lines. W.F. Blake reached its peak of about 35 or 40 employees during Portland's booming economy of the late 1960s and early 1970s, said his son.

"He was right in there doing the plumbing work for two-thirds of his life," said his son. He retired in the early 1970s.

William L. Blake, 87, for 60 years prominently identified with the business life of this City and for about 30 years a trustee of the Portland Water District, many years its president, died this morning in his home, 54 Eastern Promenade. He had been in failing health several months.

One of the original members of the Board of Trustees of the Water District upon its organization in 1907, Mr. Blake was throughout his membership, ending in 1936, one of the leading factors in determining and maintaining its business policy. Interested in philanthropic and related activities he was a generous supporter and a valued adviser.

Mr. Blake was born in Portland

Aug. 9, 1858, and was educated in the Portland schools, including Portland High School. In 1885 he organized the W. L. Blake Company, wholesale mill and plumbers supplies, continuing in the active management until a few years ago, serving as its president and manager many years. His knowledge of products was a factor in his contribution to the efficiency of the Portland Water District during his service as trustee.

He was president of the Cumberland Savings & Loan Association and of the former United States Trust Company.

A 32nd degree Mason, he was a member of Portland Lodge, AF&AM, and Portland Commandery, Knights Templar, and the Scottish Rite bodies. He was also a member of the Portland Rotary Club, the Woodfords Club, the Portland Club, and of St. Lawrence Congregational Church.

Surviving are a son, Arthur W. Blake of this City, associated with his father's firm; a daughter, Mrs. Walter A. Conley of Morristown, N. J.; and four grandchildren, including Ensign Sherman W. Blake, USN, of this City. Mrs. Blake died in 1936.
