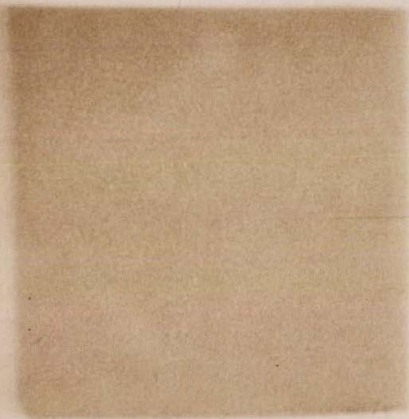

MADISON - Chester E. "Ducky" Blizzard, 88, a longtime Main Street filling station operator, died Friday at Maplecrest Living Center, where he was a patient for about a year.

He was born in Victoria Mill, New Brunswick, a son of Lemuel and Ada Nichols Blizzard, and attended Victoria Mills schools.

In 1929, he married the former Myrtle Waddington and they moved to Portland. They celebrated their 60th wedding anniversary June 19, 1989.

Mr. Blizzard lived on Tremont Street in the Thornton Heights section of South Portland for many years. While in the area, he worked in the shipping and receiving departments of the H.H. Hay Drug Co. and the E.G. Foden Co.

In 1949 he moved to Madison, where he owned and operated an Esso filling station at the corner of Main Street and Old Point Avenue, at the only traffic light in town.

During the 1950s the filling station was a gathering point of area farmers, millworkers and townspeople. They would congregate at the station in the summer months to drink nickel Cokes and discuss local and world affairs. In the winter they would gather around the stove for heat and more conversation.

Mr. Blizzard retired in 1967 and that site is currently a drug store.

He was past president of the Thornton Heights Men's

Club of South Portland, a past master of Euclid Lodge of Masons, AF & AM of Madison, past district deputy grand master of the 13th Masonic District of the Grand Lodge of Maine, a member of the Scottish Rite Bodies, Kora Temple Shrine of Lewiston and a member and past patron of the Minerva Chapter of the Order of the Eastern Star in Madison.

He was a past dad advisor of the Madison Assembly Order of the Rainbow for Girls, a member and past president of the Madison Kiwanis Club and a member and past Deacon of the Madison Congregational Church.

Mr. Blizzard played the role of Santa Claus at Christmas parties for several different organizations for many years. He was said to have played a very convincing Santa annually at Madison High School and for Kiwanis children's parties and at church, Masonic and OES functions. His daughter, Marion, related, however, that even when she was very small she could recognize his voice with the first Ho! Ho! Ho!

Survivors include his wife of Madison; and his daughter, Marion Blizzard of Atlanta, Ga.

A memorial service will be held at 2:30 p.m. Saturday at the Madison Congregational Church. The Rev. Donald Leach will officiate. Burial will be in Gracelawn Memorial Park, Auburn. Arrangements are by the Edwards Funeral Home, 165 Main St.
