SKOWHEGAN — Harold T Boardman, 85, passed away at hi residence Monday evening, Oct 26, 1998.

He was born Sept. 15, 1913, in Solon, the son of Herbert and Hattie (Rowell) Boardman. He married the former Bea Michaud (April 27, 1941.

He was a graduate o Skowhegan High School, Class o 1932. He graduated from the University of Maine at Orono ii 1936 with a B.S. degree in forestry. He served as president of his fraternity. Lambda Chi Alpha, and watreasurer of his class in 1936. H. was elected to XI Sigma Pi Honor Society in forestry. Upon gradua tion he was commissioned as a second lieutenant in the armed forces.

He was reactivated Sept. 26, 1950, for services in the Korean War. He received several medals of commendation: the Korean Service Medal, Combat Infantrymen's Badge with Star, United Nations Campaign Medal, and the Republic of Korea Presidential Unit Citation. All totaled he served 15 years, eight months and six days on active and inactive duty for his country.

Mr. Boardman was a member of Keystone Masonic Lodge in Solon, a member of Fraternal Order of the Elks, past member of New England Lumbermen's Association, past member of Skowhegan Lions' Club and a communicant of Federated Church in Skowhegan. He served on the first Planning Board in the town of Skowhegan and was an active member of the Boy Scouts for 10 years.

He owned and operated Boardman Lumber Co. with his brother, Robert Boardman, now deceased. The mill was in operation for 35 years and was located in Conville off Route 150.

Survivors include his wife, Bea, of 57 years, who lovingly cared for him at home during his long illness. Other survivors include one daughter, Jeanne (Boardman) Hogate and her husband, Melvin, of Cornville; five sons, Ronald and his wife, Deborah of Saratoga Springs, N.Y.: Douglas of Warwick, R.I.; Richard and his wife, Sally, of Scarborough; Brian of Baltimore, Md.: Thomas and his wife, Teresa of Gilford, N.H . daughter-in-law. Annette Boardman of Fairfield; 17 grandchildren; three great-grandchildren; several nicces and nephews,

Upon retirement he enjoyed designing and crafting beautiful pieces of furniture for his family.

At his request there will be no visiting hours.

A burial will take place at the Veterans Memorial Cemetery in Augusta. A private family service will be held at the memorial chapel at a later date. Arrangements are by Smart & Edwards Funeral Home of Skowhegan.




