ROCKLAND — Kenneth Alva Boardman, 85, died Tuesday at Penobscot Bay Medical Center.

He was born in Jefferson, a son of Herbert and Flora Lash Boardman.

Mr. Boardman was a master electrician and owned and operated an electrical business.

During World War II he worked for the Navy as an electrical inspector on auxiliary tugs. He wired the first AC/DC auxiliary switchboard on the submarine Tang II at the Portsmouth Naval Shipyard.

He attended Central Maine Medical Center in Lewiston, where he trained to be a licensed practical nurse. He worked at Knox County General Hospital in Rockland as well as hospitals in Gardiner, Rumford, Richmond and North Monmouth.

Mr. Boardman produced the "Kenny Boardman Breakfast Show" broadcast through WRDO in Augusta and a news commentary, "No Foolin'" through WFAU in Augusta.

He also worked as a musician and sometimes entertained at the Rainbow Room in the Thorndike Hotel. While performing at the hotel he worked with stars of the locally made movie "Deep Water," including Dana Andrews, Jean Peters and Caesar Romero.

He was a member of the Union Masonic Lodge and International Order of Odd Fellows.

His second wife, June Watts Boardman, died previously.

Surviving are his wife, Alma Boardman of Rockland; two sons, Sterling Boardman of Portsmouth, N.H., and Dana Boardman of Waldoboro; and six grandchildren.

A graveside service will be announced by Carpenter Funeral Home at a later date. Burial will be held at the convenience of the family in Orff's Corner Cemetery, Waldoboro.

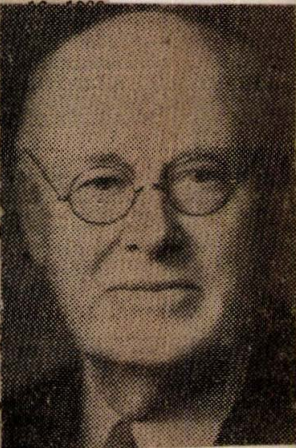

Augusta, July 11 — Thomas Henry Bodge, 76, Kennebec State Senator in 1934, clerk and treasurer of the Augusta Water District since 1937, assistant treasurer of the State Trust Company from 1906 to 1933, and a 33rd degree Mason, died at his home, 17 Murray Street, Augusta, early Saturday morning after a long illness. Funeral services will be held at 2 p. m. Tuesday, at the home.

Mr. Bodge was born August 12, 1859, in Fayette, the son of Henry and Charlotte W. Ormsby Bodge. Mr. Bodge married Miss Emma V. Stimpson of Augusta, Nov. 23, 1893, in the house at 17 Murray Street where they have always since made their home. He is survived by his wife, one nephew, John H. Bamford of Fayette, a niece, Mrs. Alfred Piper of Lynn, Mass., and a cousin, Chester H. Sturtevant of Livermore Falls. Mr. Bodge was a Democrat.
