Dr. William W. Bolster

LEWISTON, Aug. 12 (Special)—Dr. William Wheeler Bolster, 70, attached to the Central Maine General Hospital staff since 1910, died Friday night at the hospital. He had been ill since May.

A native of Mexico, Me., he attended Auburn public schools and Nichols Latin School. He received his AB Degree from Bates College in 1895 and his doctorate in medicine from the Maine Medical School in 1908.

He was instructor in physiology, hygiene and physical education at

Bates from 1895 to 1905 and taught anatomy at the Maine Medical School from 1910 to 1924.

His father, the late William W. Bolster, was mayor of Auburn in 1893 and Dr. Bolster married Maude L. Furbush, daughter of the late Mayor Furbush of Lewiston in 1914.

Dr. Bolster was a member of the Lewiston Federated Church, a past potentate of Kora Temple and member of the Androscoggin County and American Medical Associations, former member of the Auburn School Board and house surgeon at Poland Spring for 26 years.

Besides his widow, he leaves two daughters, Mrs. John R. Fales of Providence, R. I., and Hilda Bolster of Lewiston; a sister, Martha F. Bolster of Newtonville, Mass.; and two grandchildren, Nancy Bolster Fales and Eleanor Richmond Fales.

Mr. Bolton was born in Portland, Nov. 7, 1887, son of Charles F. and Mary Davis Bolton. He attended school here and was graduated from Portland High School.

Bangor, June 7—Charles R. Bond, 66, retired Bangor business man and for many years manager of the local store of the Eastern Grain Company of Portland and Bangor, died at his home here today after a long illness. Mr. Bond was a native of Stetson, attended the schools in that town and when 20 years old came to Bangor and entered the employ of the C. R. Ireland Company, grain merchants. Ralph M. Bonney, 53, for more than 25 years identified with the automobile business here and a past president of the Maine Automobile Association, died suddenly Thursday at Fort Myers Beach, Fla.
