SANFORD -- Hilliard (Slim) Melburn Boothby, 86, of Sanford died peacefully in his sleep on March 16, 2007, after a long brave fight against cancer.

He was born on July 29, 1920, in Parsonsfield. He was one of five children of Christine (Hill) Boothby and Jesse Boothby. He attended Limerick schools up until his senior year in High school. He graduated from Parsonsfield Seminary in 1938. He was actively involved in all sports during his high school years, and was known as a top notch 1st baseman in the region.

After graduation, he worked in local lumberyards until enlisting in the U.S. Navy in October of 1942. After basic training in Newport, R.I., he attended Diesel training classes at the University of Detroit. He graduated at the top of his class and was assigned as machinist first class on LST 343 out of Seattle, Wash. During his service years, he saw action in several South Pacific sites. His ship was used in the invasions of Guam, Guadalcanal, Iwa Jima, New Guinea, and several other sites. At Guadalcanal he fired so many rounds from his 40mm cannon that the barrel literally started to melt.

Near the island of Rendova, while delivering mail, the Higgins boat he was in was sunk by an unexpected water spout. He was in the water for 13 hours before landing on a island of Talagi. He and three other survivors had to make their way to the other side of the island to find help, as the side they landed on was in Japanese hands. During his duties in the South Pacific, he was shot through the leg by a Japanese sniper and later was injured from shrapnel from a Kamakazie attack.

On Feb. 20, 1942, he married Dorothea I. Bickford in a small ceremony held in Cornish. They lived entire 65 years of marriage in the Sanford/Springvale area. Slim worked for Walter Reeks Buick as a mechanic and later as the service manager for Wescott Ford. He and Tom Mackay Sr. owned two filling stations in Springvale for over 20 years.

Slim was a member of the Springvale Masonic Lodge #190 AF & AM. He was a former assistant chief of the Springvale Fire Dept., a trustee and Sunday School teacher at the Free Baptist Church in Springvale, a member of the Sanford Country Club for many years. He was also an avid hunter and always enjoyed the outdoors.

He is predeceased by a brother, E. Harry Boothby. He is survived by his wife, Dorothea Bickford Boothby of 65 years; and one son, Robert Boothby and his wife Kaye; a granddaughter, Lynn Boothby; and great-grandson, Jack Boothby Darling; two sisters, Barbara Price and Jessell Newman of Jacksonville, Fla.; and one brother, Dan Boothby of South Parsonsfield.

The family would like to thank all the personnel of Beacon Hospice, The Mayflower, Harbor House in York, and the Newton Center in Sanford for the excellent care that Hilliard received while in their care.

LIMINGTON — Ray C. Boothby, 84, a third-generation farmer and a former selectman who lived on North Road, died Thursday at Maine Medical Center after a brief illness.

All his life, Mr. Boothby owned and operated a large farm atop Boothby Hill, overlooking Route 25. His grandfather Willard Boothby and his father, Percy Boothby, ran the farm before him.

PASSAGES

Each day the newspaper selects one obituary and seeks to learn more about the life of a person who has lived and worked in Maine. We look for a person who has made a mark on the community or the person's family and circle of friends in small but lasting ways.

Mr. Boothby had about 60 head of cattle on 100 acres, and sold his milk to Locust Farm Dairy a mile down the road.

He always had oxen at the farm, which he used for logging in the winter and entered in pulling competitions at most agricultural fairs in the area.

"My grandfather, Willard, was a great hand with oxen," he said in a

1966 Press Herald interview. "I've never been without them since my father bought me my first pair at six years old."

"He was quite a teamster," said his wife, Elsie Thorne Boothby. "In 1958 he had a beautiful pair of Holstein oxen, and he won first place in every fair. In 1980 he had a pair of black ... oxen, and they won every fair. That was the last time he pulled oxen."

Mr. Boothby retired from dairy farming the same year.

During his nine years as a Limington selectman, he was seen by residents as a voice of reason. "We kind of thought of him as a reliable town fixture," one resident said about him in a Press Herald story on his retirement from the board in 1963.

While a selectman, Mr. Boothby was instrumental in getting Route 25 in Limington rebuilt.

In the late 1920s, he was the first person in Limington to use a truck to plow the town roads after snowstorms. Before that, the roads were maintained with a snow roller. His grandfather Charles Chase manufactured snow rollers.

He and his grandfather Willard Boothby picked rocks from their fields for crushing to make the first concrete bridge over the Saco River on Route 25. It replaced a wooden covered bridge that was torn down in 1929.

Born in Limington, a son of Percy and Bessie Chase Boothby, he attended Limington schools.

He was a 50-year member of both the Masons and the Order of the Eastern Star.

Surviving are his wife of 65 years, Elsie Thorne Boothby of North Limington; a son, Willard T. of Limington; a brother, B. Bors Boothby of Limington; five grandchildren and seven great-grandchildren.

A funeral will be held at 2 p.m. Monday at York Funeral Chapel, Route 25, Cornish. The Rev. John Hoskin will officiate. Burial will be in the North Limington Cemetery.



Augusta, Feb. 21—William G. Boothby, for 53 years treasurer of the Kennebec Savings Bank, and a leader in business and civic affairs of Augusta for more than 60 years, died this afternoon at his home, 87 Winthrop Street.

He had served on the School Board and in the city government, and was a pioneer in establishing the school savings plan in the state, opening first accounts for Augusta school children in 1900.

He was born at Buxton, May 4, 1860 the son of Israel O. and Hannah Smith Boothby. He came to Augusta with his parents at the age of two years, and in 1876 entered the employ of the First National Bank with his father, continuing there until 1881.

From 1881 to 1886 he was clerk in the E. C. Allen Publishing Co., and following that was for two years money order clerk in the Augusta Postoffice.

He was elected treasurer of the Kennebec Savings Bank July 2, 1888, and continued in that capacity until his death. He was at his desk in the bank daily until Nov. 1 last when he was taken ill and forced to retire home. His banking experience included a period as president of the First National Granite Bank during its consolidation period, and he also served as a vice president and director of this institution for a while.

It was while Mr. Boothby was serving on the School Board that the Lincoln School was built, and many of the committee credited his energy and foresight for placing it in an area which was to develop rapidly.

His lodge activities included membership in Augusta Lodge, F. & A. M.; Trinity Chapter, RAM; Trinity

James Bornheimer

James W. Bornheimer shipfitter, truck farmer, flier

SCARBOROUGH - James W. Bornheimer, 89, a longtime shipfitter who during the 1930s flew a biplane and was a town motorcycle policeman, died Monday at his home at 162 Black Point Road.

Mr. Bornheimer was a superintendent of hulls at the East Shipyard of the New England Shipbuilding Co. in

South Portland during World War II. There he oversaw hull construction for many of the 266 Liberty ships built there during the war.

Before the war he worked on submarines at Pearl Harbor, Hawaii. He was transferred by the government to the new South Portland operation just before the Japanese bombing.

During the 1920s, Mr. Bornheimer worked at Turner Center Milk Co., which is where he met and married his wife, Doris Fogg Bornheimer. In the 1930s, he had a Cushman Baking Co. bulk franchise and had the rights to some of its trucking routes in southern Maine.

In the 1930s Mr. Bornheimer was one of the first motorcycle police officers in Scarborough.

"I can vaguely remember it, but I've seen pictures of him," said Lombard. He was also a charter member of the town's fire department.

During that same period he used to enjoy flying a small biplane for pleasure from a runway in a field behind their house. They also had a small truck-garden-farm, raising mostly carrots and string beans.

Though he enjoyed fishing and sailing, he always worked so hard that he never found the time, according to his son. "There were 12 or 15 years where he never took a vacation. It came with the territory, back then."

Born in Waldoboro, a son of Bert L. and Bessie L. Dean Bornheimer, he attended Waldoboro schools. He was a charter member of the Spurwink Rod & Gun Club and a member of the Masons.

Surviving are his wife of 65 years, Doris Fogg Bornheimer, and his son, both of Scarborough; two daughters, Charlene Allen and Barbara Lombard, both of Gorham; a brother, Millard of Duxbury, Mass., and Florida; eight grandchildren and six great-grandchildren.
