SANFORD -- Hilliard (Slim) Melburn Boothby, 86, of Sanford died peacefully in his sleep on March 16, 2007, after a long brave fight against cancer.

He was born on July 29, 1920, in Parsonsfield. He was one of five children of Christine (Hill) Boothby and Jesse Boothby. He attended Limerick schools up until his senior year in High school. He graduated from Parsonsfield Seminary in 1938. He was actively involved in all sports during his high school years, and was known as a top notch 1st baseman in the region.

After graduation, he worked in local lumberyards until enlisting in the U.S. Navy in October of 1942. After basic training in Newport, R.I., he attended Diesel training classes at the University of Detroit. He graduated at the top of his class and was assigned as machinist first class on LST 343 out of Seattle, Wash. During his service years, he saw action in several South Pacific sites. His ship was used in the Invasions of Guam, Guadalcanal, Iwa Jima, New Guinea, and several other sites. At Guadalcanal he fired so many rounds from his 40mm cannon that the barrel literally started to melt.

Near the Island of Rendova, while delivering mail, the Higgins boat he was in was sunk by an unexpected water spout. He was in the water for 13 hours before landing on a island of Talogi. He and three other survivors had to make their way to the other side of the Island to find help, as the side they landed on was in Japanese hands. During his duties in the South Pacific, he was shot through the leg by a Japanese sniper and later was injured from a Karnakazie attack.

On Feb. 20, 1942, he married Dorothea I. Bickford in a small ceremony held in Cornish. They lived entire 65 years of marriage in the Sanford/Springvale area. Slim worked for Walter Reeks Buick as a mechanic and later as the service manager for Wescott Ford. He and Tom Mackay Sr. owned two filling stations in Springvale for over 20 years.

Slim was a member of the Springvale Masonic Lodge #190 AF & AM. He was a former assistant chief of the Springvale Fire Dept., a trustee and Sunday School teacher at the Free Baptist Church in Springvale, a member of the Sanford Country Club for many years. He was also an avid hunter and always enjoyed the outdoors.

He is predeceased by a brother, E. Harry Boothby. He is survived by his wife, Dorothea Bickford Boothby of 65 years; and one son, Robert Boothby and his wife Kaye; a granddaughter, Lynn Boothby; and greatgrandson, Jack Boothby Darling; two sisters, Barbara Price and Jesseill Newman of Jacksonville, Fla.; and one brother, Dan Boothby of South Parsonsfield.



Samuel Boothby, 83, long prominent in the drygoods business in this State and an ardent sportsmain in his active years, died Wednesday at his home, 11 Carroll Street. He had been in failing health many months and seriously ill since Spring.

Special Despatch to Sunday Telegram Augusta, Feb. 21-William G. Boothby, for 53 years treasurer of the Kennebec Savings Bank, and a leader in business and civic affairs of Augusta for more than 60 years, died this afternoon at his home, 87 Winthrop Street

He had served on the School Board and in the city government, and was a pioneer in establishing the school savings plan in the state, opening first accounts for Augusta school children in 1900.

He was born at Buxton. May 4, 1860 the son of Israel O. and Hannah Smith Boothby. He came to Augusta with his parents at the age of two years, and in 1876 entered the employ of the First National Bank with his father, continuing there until 1881. From 1881 to 1886 he was clerk in the E. C. Allen Publishing Co., and following that was for two years money order clerk in the Augusta Postoffice. He was elected treasurer of the Kennebec Savings Bank July 2, 1888, and continued in that capacity until his death.
