KENNEBUNK, Oct. 27, (Special.) William F. Bowen, 82, Civil War veteran and prominent here for many years in lodge circles, died at his home on Friend street yesterday afternoon after a brief illness. He was a native of Boston, born July 1842. He was the son of Arthur and Nancy Eaton Bowen. Shortly after the opening of the Civil War he enlisted in 35th Massachusetts Infantry and participated in the battle of Antietam. Later he was detailed to Calvary service and was on patrol duty near Appamatox when Lee surrendered.

Mr. Bowen came to this town 48 years ago. He joined York Lodge of Masons by transfer in 1887 and served this lodge as worthy master 1893-1894. At the time of his death he was commander of Web-

ber Post, G. A. R. which office he had held for a number of years. For a quarter of a century he was marshal of the annual Memorial Day parade, and was repeatedly honored by being chosen marshal at local parades, as he was a man of the carriage. He was respected and loved by the town's people, young and old. The surviving relatives are three daughters, Mary, wife of Edwin Garvin of Melrose, Mass.; Luella M. Tierney of Haverhill, Mass. and Marion E., wife of Aldo Pitts of this town, with whom he had made his home; two sons, Elvin W. Bowen of Keystone, Neb. and Harold R. Bowen of South Portland; also four grandchildren, Mrs. Gertrude A. Carlton of Melrose, Mass., Miss Ruth I. Peavey of Haverhill, Mass., Miss Irma A. Pitts of this town; and William W. F. Bowen, Jr. of Keystone, Neb.

He was predeceased by a son, Oscar Bowie, on June 15, 1995; and three brothers, Carl Bowie, Lyndon Bowie and Donald Bowie.

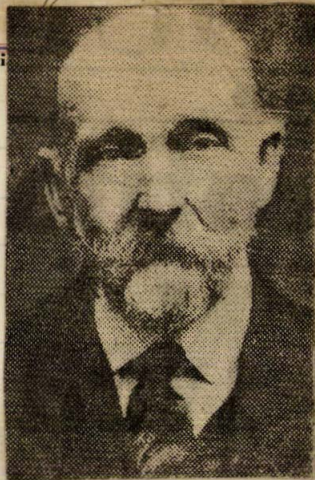

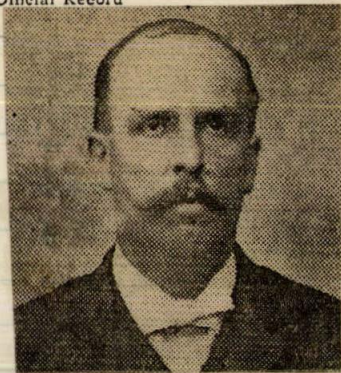

Delphinus F. Bowker

Masonic services for Delphinus F. Bowker, retired Grand Trunk conductor, will be held Monday at 2.30 p. m. at the Hay and Peabody Funeral Home, 749 Congress Street, by officers of Ancient Landmark Lodge, of which he was a member. He died Saturday morning at his home, 30 Eastern Promenade.

Mr. Bowker, who retired several years ago after nearly 50 years of service as brakeman and conductor on the Grand Trunk, had been a passenger conductor for nearly 35 years, running all that time on the Portland-Island Pond, or Portland-Montreal trains. He entered the employment of the railroad in 1880 and became a freight conductor after 10 years as a brakeman in the days when hand-brakes were used and trainmen experienced more hardships than they do today. For two or three years he was a freight conductor and then was promoted to a passenger run.
