C. Robert Bowlby

retired civil engineer, avid bear hunter

ALNA - C. Robert Bowlby, 83, died Monday at a Portland hospital after a brief illness.

He was born in Plainfield, N.J., a son of Joseph and Bessie (Mathers) Bowlby and attended New York City schools.

Mr. Bowlby began his career working with concrete in heavy construction. He was instrumental in the construction of many commercial sites, and at one time was supervising more than 6,000 men at an airport construction site in Chicago. During his 30-year career as a civil engineer, it was noted that he was responsible for setting more than a million yards of concrete.

In 1958, he and his wife, Betty (Mitchell) Bowlby, retired to Maine, and while here, he was a member of the Bristol Lodge of Masons. He was also an avid bear hunter, using professionally trained hound dogs for many years.

Mrs. Bowlby died in 1980.

Surviving are a son, Robin of Alna; a daughter Nancy Marchiani of Vermont; a sister, Dorothy McGonagle of New Jersey; and a grandson.

A private service will be held at the Bristol Mills Cemetery, with Rick Newell officiating. Arrangements are by Strong Funeral Home, Damariscotta.

SOUTH PORTLAND — Albert E. Bowler, 86, of Richland Street died June 17, 2000, at a local health care facility after a lengthy illness.

Mr. Bowler worked for the United States Postal Service for 21 years, retiring in 1977. He played the bass guitar with the Syd Lerman Band for 40 years.

He was a 32nd degree Mason, a member of Hiram Lodge in South Portland and the Valley of Portland Scottish Rite Bodies.

His wife of 58 years, Phyllis Loring Bowler, died in 1996 and a son, Robert, died in 1992.

Ernest C. Bowler, 78, former Maine educator, legislator and business manager of the Portland Press Herald, died here Monday night after a short illness at the home of his daughter, Miss Mary E. Bowler.

Born at Palermo, Me., May 6, 1870, he was a graduate of Castine Normal School. In his early life he entered the teaching profession and was successively superintendent of schools in Palermo and Bethel, Me., and later president of Waldo County Teachers Association.

He was elected to the Maine Legislature in 1913 and was instrumental in passing the first Maine teachers' pension bill.

Concurrently with teaching work

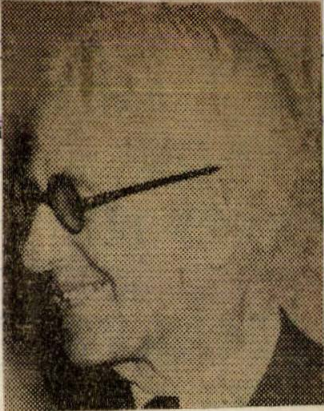

Mr. Boyd was associated with the Chapman National Bank of Portland from 1895 to 1933 and had served as cashier for over 16 years and a member of the board of directors. He was employed as chief underwriter for the Federal Housing Administration in Maine until his retirement in 1949.

Mr. Boyd recalled early banking days in Portland in an article he wrote for the July 29, 1966 issue of the Portland Evening Express.

"In 1895 all the banks and bankers were located on Middle Street from Exchange Street to Plum Street and on Exchange Street from Milk Street up. With a total of 28 banks in this one little area you would have thought there would have been competition that would have required special advertising to offer some inducement for patronizing a bank.

"I don't recall any advertising. You opened an account in a bank because you knew someone in it or you liked the looks of it."

Mr. Boyd was a charter member of the Portland Lions Club; a member of all Scottish Rite Bodies; York Rite Bodies, a 33rd Degree Mason, past master of Ancient Landmark Lodge, past Most Wise Master of Rose Croix; a member and past patron of the Deering Chapter, OES, organizer and past president of the Past Masters' Association, 17th District, an organizer of the Portland Masonic Club; and a former member of the Portland Chamber of Commerce.

He was a former member of the Portland Club and a member of the Maine Historical Society.

His wife, the former Alice Small, died in 1965. He is survived by a nephew, Richard M. Boyd of Yarmouth.
