With a total of 28 banks in this one little a r e a you would have thought there would have been competition that would have required special advertising to offer some inducement for patronizing a bank.

"I don't recall any advertising. You opened an account in a bank because you knew someone in it or you liked the looks of it."

Mr. Boyd was a charter member of the Portland Lions Club; a member of all Scottish Rite Bodies; York Rite Bodies, a 33rd Degree Mason, past master of Ancient Landmark Lodge, past Most Wise Master of Rose Croix; a member and past patron of the Deering Chapter, OES, organizer and past president of the Past Masters' Association, 17th District, an organizer of the Portland Masonic Club; and a former member of the Portland Chamber of Commerce.
