He is survived by his wife of Readfield; one son, Milton L. Bradford Jr. of Wilmington, Mass.; two daughters, Sylvia B. Moreau of Readfield and Crystal B. Dodge of South Easton, Mass.; seven grandchildren, and four great-grandchildren.

Roswell C. Bradford, who died Friday at his summer home at Danforth Cove, South Portland, was born at Mexico, Me., in 1855. He had made his home in Portland since 1879 and during all these years he had the respect and confidence of all who came in contact with him.

But to those who knew him intimately was granted the inspiration of knowing a man at his best; rather frail in appearance, the clean, generous and sympathetic character of the man so dominated his personality that the effect was one of marked strength.

Liberal and kindly in his judgment of others, he was uncompromising in his adherence to his own high standards. His life leaves none but pleasant memories and to his friends gives confidence to face the future unafraid.

Following his graduation from Hebron Academy he became an instructor in the commercial department, serving until 1877. The following year he entered the service of the Rumford Falls & Buckfield Railroad Company and until his death was connected with the railroads serving Rumford. In June he completed 56 years of service with these companies.

He was a director of the Portland National Bank, the Oxford Paper Company and the Union Safe Deposit and Trust Company and a member of the Masonic Blue Lodge of Canton.
