




after a brief illness. The funeral will be conducted Monday at 2 p. m.


Surviving are a sister, Mrs. Sadie O'Neill, Portland, and three cousins. His wife, the former Fanniel Maxfield, died in 1949.




## Charles Stephen Bradstreet

He was active in local politics and served as the Chamber of Commerce President in San Dimas f or one year. A man of vast knowledge, he was an independent thinker, philosophically sound with inspiring communication skills. His life was long, productive and touching to those who met him. He was a charmed man and well deserving. He is survived by his loving wife Winnie, caring sister Mildred, three proud children Bette. Stephen and Charlie, and two grandson's Jason and Scott. 




