In 1981, Dr. Branson was recipient of the A.H. Robbins Award to a physician for Outstanding Community Service. In addition, he was a member of Presumpscot Lodge of Masons, Scottish Rite Consistory of the Valley of Portland, and of the Kora Shrine; belonged to the Knights of Pythias, Odd Fellows and Pleasant River Grange; and was past president of Windham Kiwanis Club. He married Nora R.

Baker of Fort Kent in 1939. In Windham, they raised three children: Sandra E. Williams (now of Cape Elizabeth), S. Robert Branson, Jr. (now of Scarborough), and John B. William Sylvanus Brawn

Camden grocer, community leader

CAMDEN - William Sylvanus Brawn, 84, died Monday at Tall Pines Health Care Facility in Belfast.

Born in Liberty, he was the son of Fred Preston and Elizabeth Caroline Preston Brawn. Before his first birthday, his father died from an accidental gunshot wound, and he lived in foster care through most of his youth, with much of his childhood spent at the Peavey farm in Palermo.

Mr. Brawn graduated from Freedom Academy in 1930, from the Maine School of Commerce, Auburn, in 1934 and from the University of Maine in 1941. He taught business education at the Maine School of Commerce, and

in high schools at Brooks, Islesboro, Norway and Rumford.

On Aug. 26, 1939, he married Shirley C. Young of Lincolnville Beach. He enlisted in the Army in December 1941, graduated from Officers Candidate School and served two years in the Pacific as an Army Air Corps combat intelligence officer. He received five combat stars, the Bronze Star medal and a battlefield promotion to first lieutenant.

After the war, he served in the Air Force Reserve from 1946 to 1973, retiring as a lieutenant colonel.

In 1953, he became manager with his wife's uncle, M. Alton French, and later joined him in 1963 as partner in the French & Brawn Grocery Store. He became sole owner in 1970, and retired in 1977.

Mrs. Brawn died on Feb. 19, 1989.

His civic involvement including heading the board of the First Congregational Church (UCC) here and the Camden Lions Club. He was a 50-year member of Island Masonic Lodge at Islesboro, and many other Masonic organizations, was a former vice president of the Maine Teachers Association and the National Education Association, and a life member of the VFW.

In 1979, he was elected a Camden selectmen and served as chairman in 1982-83. In 1985, Mr. Brawn was honored by the Rockport-Camden-Lincolnville Chamber of Commerce as Townsperson of the Year.

He was also recognized as Retailer of the Year by the Associated Grocers of Maine in 1978, and served as director for the former Camden Community Hospital and Health Care Center. He was also very active in Republican town and county committees.

On June 27, 1992, Mr. Brawn married Ruth French Bowen in Camden. They shared many happy moments together between Camden and Zephyrhills, Fla.

Surviving, besides his wife, are three sons, W. Preston Brawn of Medford, N.J.; Jeffrey F. of Camden, and Robert A. of Belfast; and four grandsons.

Visiting hours are from 7 to 9 p.m. Wednesday at Laite & Pratt Funeral Home, 9 Mountain St. A funeral will be held at 1 p.m. Thursday in the First Congregational Church, 55 Elm St., with the Rev. Glen Rainsley officiating. Burial will be in French Cemetery, Lincolnville.

Brunswick, July 17.—Worthen E. Brawn, 53, superintendent of the Pejepscot Paper Mills here and one of Brunswick's most prominent citizens, died this morning aboard the Cunard liner Queen Elizabeth, shortly after it sailed from New York for Southampton, England. Edgar S. Catlin, mill vice president, announced this afternoon.

Brawn, with his wife, Mrs. Goldie Brawn, was en route to Europe for a two-months tour of England, Scotland, Finland and Sweden, to study the pulp and paper industries in those countries.

In a cablegram to Catlin, Mrs. Brawn said that her husband suffered a heart ailment shortly after he went aboard the ship at 7 a. m. today and was examined by the ship's doctor and ordered to bed. Shortly after the liner sailed, he suffered a second, and fatal relapse.

A Cunard spokesman in New York said Mrs. Brawn asked to have the body put ashore but it
