Lyman F. Brewer, 86, of Ludlow Street, a retired chief engineer for Guy Gannett Broadcasting, died Wednesday at his home.

He was born here, a son of William and Vienna Norton Brewer, attended local schools and graduated from Deering High School in 1931. He graduated from the University of Maine in 1935 with high distinction in electrical engineering, and was elected to Tau Beta Pi and Phi Kappa Phi honor societies.

He was employed by the Mt. Washington Cog Railway and the Venetian Hotel in Miami from 1935 to 1938 and worked at the Naval Research Laboratories in Washington, D.C., as a radio engineer from 1942 to 1945. He later worked for WGAN radio, where he was chief engineer for Guy Gan-

nett Broadcasting Services, WGAN-AM-FM TV and was the design engineer at WGME-TV facilities at Northport studios, supervising construction for that location in 1977. He retired in 1978.

He was a member of the Woodfords Congregational Church, where he was a past deacon, moderator and chairman of the board of trustees.

He was a member, past president and past chairman of the board of trustees of the Woodfords Club, a member of the Deering Lodge of Masons, and a member of the Portland Shriners.

He was a life member of Maine Association of Engineers and Institute of Electrical and Electronic Engineers, a member of the Newcomen Society, a member and former board member of the Maine Charitable Mechanics Association, a member of the Maine Historical Society, a member of the Seashore Trolley Museum, 470 Railroad Club, Cumberland and Oxford Canal Association and the Maine Genealogical Society.

His wife, Alice Brewer, died in 1990.

**SACO —** George E. Brickates, 69, of 18 Meadow Lane, died Sunday in Philadelphia while returning from the AHEPA convention in St. Louis.

He was born in Saco, a son of Elias P. and Evanthia Demestihis Brickates, and graduated from Thornton Academy in 1939. He graduated cum laude from Bowdoin College in the class of 1943 and from the Boston University Law School in 1949.

He was a Navy officer and had studied at the Naval Midshipmen's School at Columbia University, New York City, and from the Naval Communications School at Harvard.

Mr. Brickates served in Northern Africa and the European and North Pacific theaters during World War II. He was named administrative assistant to Admiral Monroe Kelly III, commandant of the Third Naval District out of New York City.

He was honored by the Disabled American Veterans in 1955 and in 1957 received a distinguished service award from the Amvets. He was a former national vice commander and state commander of the Amvets.
