





COLON 'COLE' V. BRIDGES

CALAIS - Colon V. Bridges, 94, of 21 Lincoln St., died Sept. 17, 1990, at a Calais nursing home, after a long illness. He was born at Charlotte. He was a 65-year member of the Masons, Crescent Lodge No. 78 and a member of the Sherman Brothers Post No. 3, American Legion of Calais. After receiving his pilots license in the infancy of the industry, he was active well into his 80s, and was a member of A.O.P.A. and the National Aeronautic Flying Club. He was a charter member of the St. Croix Country Club, an equestrian, and an avid sportsman all his life. He is survived by his wife of 50-years, Helene (Boone) Bridges; two sons and daughters-in-law. 

manager.




